Mark 1:35 (NASB) 35 In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there.

Matthew 14:13 (NASB) 13 Now when Jesus heard about John, He withdrew from there in a boat to a secluded place by Himself; and when the people heard of this, they followed Him on foot from the cities.

Matthew 14:23 (NASB) 23 After He had sent the crowds away, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray; and when it was evening, He was there alone.

Mark 1:36-38 (NASB) 36 Simon and his companions searched for Him; 37 they found Him, and said to Him, "Everyone is looking for You." 38 He said to them, "Let us go somewhere else to the towns nearby, so that I may preach there also; for that is what I came for."

Psalm 143:8 (NASB) 8 Let me hear Your lovingkindness in the morning; For I trust in You; Teach me the way in which I should walk; For to You I lift up my soul.

 They Were Ostracized From The Jewish

- Community.
  They Were Also Prohibited From Worship.
  When Lepers Traveled From One Location To Another They Had To Warn Others By Shouting "Unclean, Unclean".

  • If You Touched A Leper You Would Be Declared Ceremonially Unclean.

## Jesus is Over It All...Even The Unclean!

Mark 1:40-41 (NASB) 40 And a man with leprosy came to Jesus, imploring Him and kneeling down, and saying to Him, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." 41 Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out with His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."
