What Does Verse 19 Look Like in the Life Of Our Church Now? What Specific Acts Are Going On In Our Church That Remind You of Verse 19?

In verse 20 we read, "Nevertheless, I have this against you." No church is problem free or sin free. Some problems are subtle and very dangerous. It is easy for us to brush off what we consider "small sins." But why is it important to deal with all sins big or small? Discuss and then read 1 Cor.5:6,

Gal.5:9, Gal.6:7-10. What have you seen in real life that supports this idea? What Are Some Sins In Our Church "That Seem" To Go Uncheck?

In Verse 21 "This False Prophetess" is Leading The Church Astray With False Truth. What Are Some Ways That The Devil Can Dress Up False Truth in the Church To Trick People into Following Him?

In v.21 it sounds like Jesus was Patient also. Why was Jesus patient? What can we learn from this as to how we should practice tolerance in the church or at home?
