Acts 2:42-47 (NASB) 42 They were **continually devoting themselves** to the apostles' teaching and **to fellowship**, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 43

Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles. 44 And all those who had believed **were together and had all things in common;**

45 and they began selling their property and possessions and **were sharing them with all**, as anyone might have need. 46 Day by day **continuing with one mind** in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, **they were taking their meals together** with gladness and sincerity of heart,
