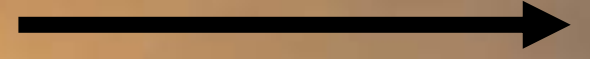

Massive Loss of Life:

- Revelation 6:8 – $\frac{1}{4}$ of world's population killed by 4th horseman
- This judgement brings death to $\frac{1}{3}$ of those remaining alive



Hardened Hearts in Those Who Didn't Repent

Revelation 9:20–21 (NLT) — “But the people who did not die in these plagues still **refused to repent** of their evil deeds and turn to God. They continued to worship demons and idols made of gold, silver, bronze, stone, and wood—idols that can neither see nor hear nor walk! **21** And **they did not repent** of their murders or their witchcraft or their sexual immorality or their thefts.”

Ephesians 5:6 (NLT) — “Don’t be fooled by those who try to excuse these sins, for the anger of God will fall on all who disobey him.”

“Dear friends, if we deliberately continue sinning after we have received knowledge of the truth, there is no longer any sacrifice that will cover these sins. **27** There is only the terrible expectation of God’s judgment and the raging fire that will consume his enemies. **28** For anyone who refused to obey the law of Moses was put to death without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. **29** Just think how much worse the punishment will be for those who have trampled on the

Hebrews 10:26-31 (NLT)

Son of God, and have treated the blood of the covenant, which made us holy, as if it were common and unholy, and have insulted and disdained the Holy Spirit who brings God's mercy to us. **30** For we know the one who said, 'I will take revenge. I will pay them back.' He also said, 'The LORD will judge his own people.' **31** It is a terrible thing to fall into the hands of the living God."

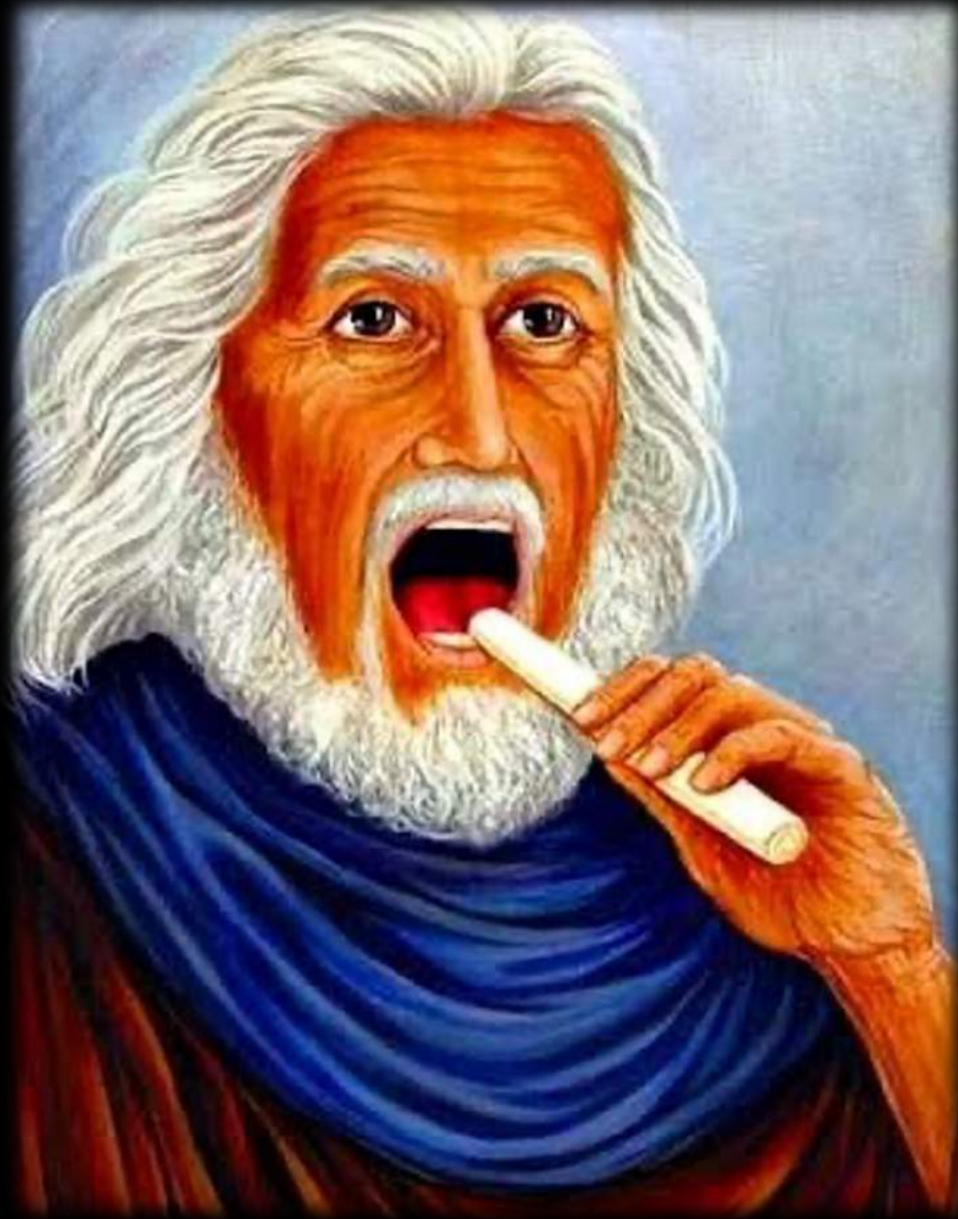


Revelation 10

Revelation 10:8–9 (NLT) — “Then the voice from heaven spoke to me again: ‘Go and take the open scroll from the hand of the angel who is standing on the sea and on the land.’ **9** So I went to the angel and told him to give me the small scroll. ‘Yes, take it and eat it,’ he said. ‘It will be sweet as honey in your mouth, but it will turn sour in your stomach!’”

Revelation 11:19 (NLT) — “Then, in heaven, the Temple of God was opened and the Ark of his covenant could be seen inside the Temple. Lightning flashed, thunder crashed and roared, and there was an earthquake and a terrible hailstorm.”

Who is This Woman?

- Represents Israel
- Red Dragon = Satan

Revelation 12:15 (NLT) — “Then the dragon tried to drown the woman with a flood of water that flowed from his mouth.”

Revelation 12:16–17 (NLT) — “But the earth helped her by opening its mouth and swallowing the river that gushed out from the mouth of the dragon. **17** And the dragon was angry at the woman and declared war against the rest of her children—**all who keep God’s commandments and maintain their testimony for Jesus.**”
