



  - 2 Egyptian midwives who helped save Israelite baby boys


**Exodus 1:16-17 (NLT)** — "When you help the Hebrew women as they give birth, watch as they deliver. If the baby is a boy, kill him; if it is a girl, let her live. But because the midwives feared God, they refused to obey the king's orders. They allowed the boys to live, too."



Shiphrah & Puah Saved Many Hebrew Baby Boys

Exodus 1:18–19 (NLT) — "So the king of Egypt called for the midwives. 'Why have you done this?' he demanded. 'Why have you allowed the boys to live?' 19 'The Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women,' the midwives replied. 'They are more vigorous and have their babies so quickly that we cannot get there in time."
