Ephesians 3:20 (NKJV) — “Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, **according to the power that works in us...**”

Romans 8:11 (NKJV) — “But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies **through His Spirit who dwells in you.**”

“Ever since I first heard of your strong faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for God’s people everywhere, **16** I have not stopped thanking God for you. I pray for you constantly, **17** asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, **to give you spiritual wisdom and insight** so that you might grow in your knowledge of God. **18** I pray that **your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called** — his holy people who

are his rich and glorious inheritance. **19** I also pray that **you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him.** This is the same mighty power **20** that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honor at God's right hand in the heavenly realms. **21** Now he is far above any ruler or authority or power or leader or anything else—not only in this world but also in the world to come. **22 God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has**
