- G. Chooses leadership
  - Acts 20:28
- Η. Divine names and titles given to the Holy Spirit
  - Holy Ghost / Holy Spirit... used 97x's
  - Spirit of God... The Spirit of the Lord... The Spirit of the Living God

# 3. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Holy Spirit

- A. Personal **pronouns** are used in reference to the Holy Spirit:
  - John 15:26, 16:7
- B. Personal attributes are ascribed to Him:
  - Mind... Romans 8:27
  - Knowledge... 1 Corinthians 2:10-11
  - Personal Will/Volition... 1 Corinthians 12:11, 14:1
  - Emotions... He can be:
    - i. Grieved... Isaiah 63:10, Ephesians 4:30
    - ii. Lied to ... Acts 5:3
    - iii. Blasphemed... Matthew 12:31-32
      - The unpardonable sin today is the state of continued unbelief
      - The Spirit currently convicts the unsaved world of sin, righteousness, and judgment (John 16:8)
      - To resist that conviction and willfully remain unrepentant is to "blaspheme" the Spirit
    - iv. Insulted... Hebrews 10:9
    - v. Resisted... Acts 7:51
    - vi. Obeyed... Acts 10:19-20, 23
