





Moral Power

- the ability to live a holy life
- characterized by being separate from the ways of the world

Ephesians 1:4 (NLT) — "Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes."

Hebrews 12:14 (NLT) — "Work at living in peace with everyone, and work at living a holy life, for those who are not holy will not see the Lord."

1 Peter 1:15–16 (NLT) — "But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy.

16 For the Scriptures say, 'You must be holy because I am holy."



Romans 6:11–13 (NLT) — "So you also should consider yourselves to be dead to the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus. 12 Do not let sin control the way you live; do not give in to sinful desires. 13 Do not let any part of your body become an instrument of evil to serve sin. And instantly it left her."


