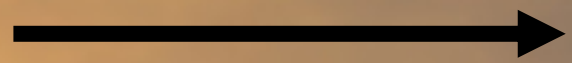

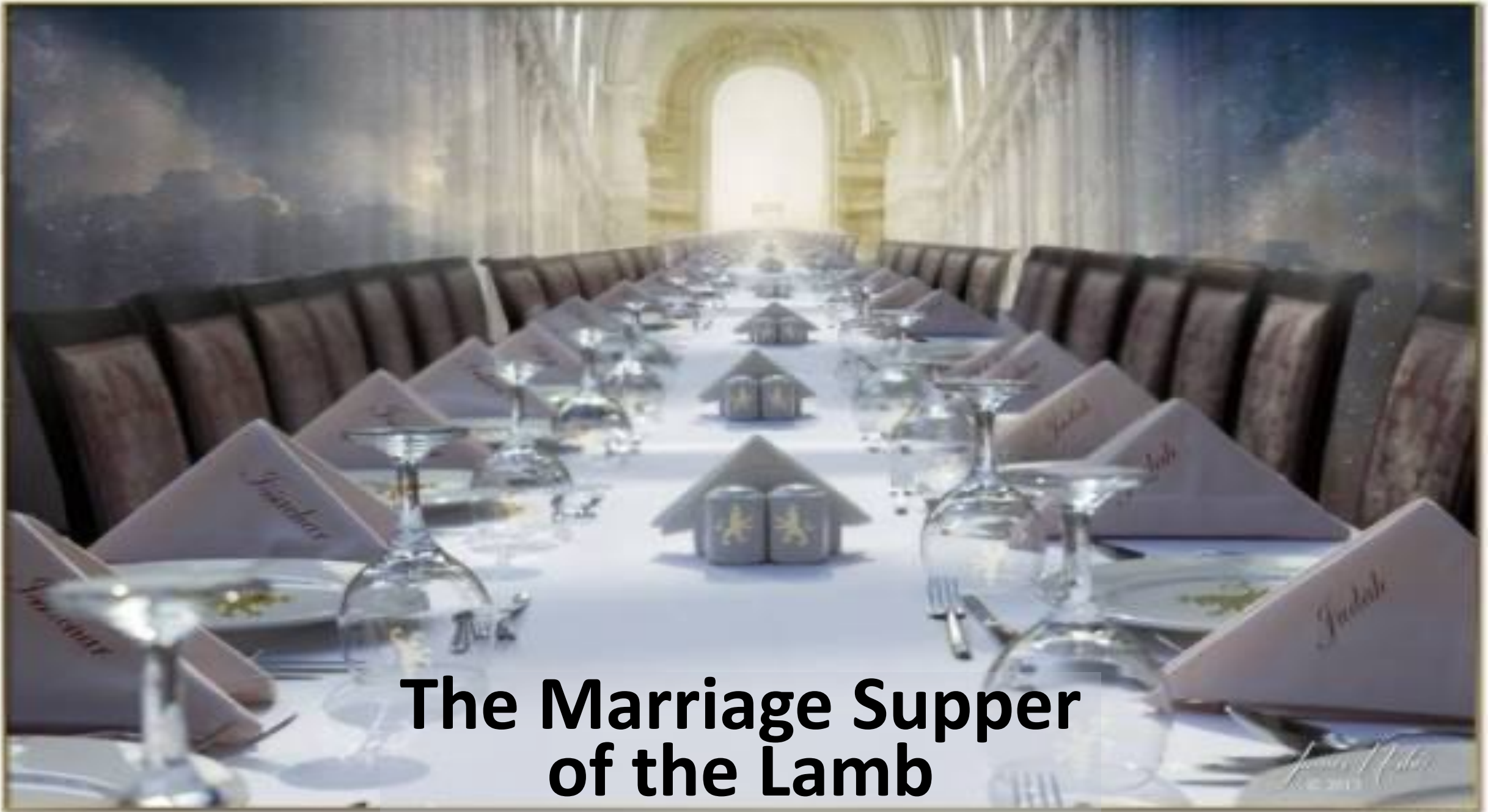

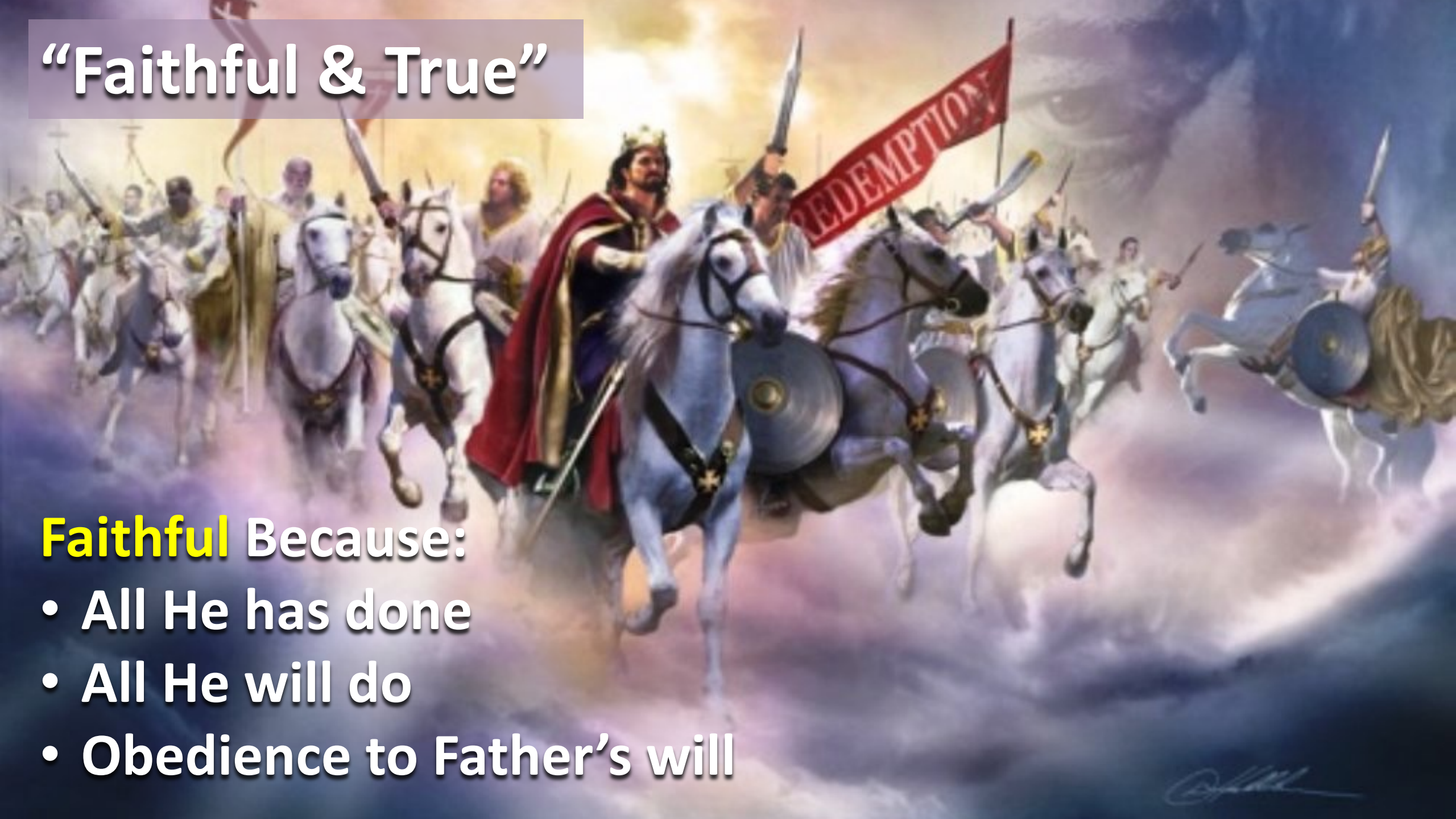

True Because:

- True to His word
- All He's promised will come true



“With justice He judges and will make war”

- He will return as a warrior to judge the inhabitants of the earth
- He will deal with their sin, settle their eternal destinies, and establish His reign



“With justice He judges and will make war”

- He judges justly because He knows all and sees all, nothing is hidden from His eyes



“His eyes are like blazing fire”

- Reveals His insight, knowledge, and anger
- Reflects His anger over the injustice and sin of humanity



“Many crowns on His head”

- Speaks of His authority, His royalty, and His majesty
- He will have full authority on heaven, and on earth
- No one will doubt His right to rule when He is done



“A name written on Him which no one knows”

- Maybe the same name as in Revelation 3:12

*“And I will write on them the name of my God, and they will be citizens in the city of my God—the new Jerusalem that comes down from heaven from my God. **And I will also write on them my new name.**”*



“Robe dipped in blood”

- Symbol of what is about to take place

“Who is this who comes from Edom, from the city of Bozrah, **with his clothing stained red**? Who is this in royal robes, marching in his great strength? ‘It is I, the LORD, announcing your salvation! It is I, the LORD, who has the power to save!’ **2** Why are your clothes so red, as if you have been treading out grapes? **3** ‘I have been treading the winepress alone; no one was there to help me. In my anger I have trampled my enemies as if they were grapes. In my fury I have trampled my foes. Their

blood has stained my clothes. **4** For the time has come for me to avenge my people, to ransom them from their oppressors. **5** I was amazed to see that no one intervened to help the oppressed. So I myself stepped in to save them with my strong arm, and my wrath sustained me. **6 I crushed the nations in my anger and made them stagger and fall to the ground, spilling their blood upon the earth.’’**

Isaiah 63:1-6 (NLT)

Revelation 14:20 (NLT) — “The grapes were trampled in the winepress outside the city, and blood flowed from the winepress in a stream about 180 miles long and as high as a horse’s bridle.”

Revelation 19:13 (NLT) — “He wore a robe dipped in blood, and **his title was the Word of God.**”

John 1:1–4 (NLT) — “In the beginning the Word already existed. **The Word was with God, and the Word was God.** **2** He existed in the beginning with God. **3** God created everything through him, and nothing was created except through him. **4** The Word gave life to everything that was created, and his life brought light to everyone.”

John 1:14 (NLT) — “So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father’s one and only Son.”

“The armies of Heaven were following Him”

- White horse symbolic of a conqueror
- Being mounted on a white horse shows honor
- All the Body of Christ will be mounted and following Him
- We won't be the ones fighting

Jesus will be the only one carrying a weapon...

- The Word of God
- He will simply speak a word and the enemy will be utterly destroyed

Joel 3:1–2 (NLT) — “At the time of those events,’ says the LORD, ‘when I restore the prosperity of Judah and Jerusalem, **2 I will gather the armies of the world into the valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will judge them for harming my people,** my special possession, for scattering my people among the nations, and for dividing up my land.’”

“Say to the nations far and wide: ‘Get ready for war! Call out your best warriors. Let all your fighting men advance for the attack. **10** Hammer your plowshares into swords and your pruning hooks into spears. Train even your weaklings to be warriors. **11** Come quickly, all you nations everywhere. Gather together in the valley.’ And now, O LORD, call out your warriors! **12** ‘Let the nations be called to arms. Let them march to the valley of Jehoshaphat. There I, the LORD, will sit to pronounce

judgment on them all. **13** Swing the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. **Come, tread the grapes, for the winepress is full.** The storage vats are overflowing with the wickedness of these people.' **14 Thousands upon thousands are waiting in the valley of decision.** There the day of the LORD will soon arrive. **15** The sun and moon will grow dark, and the stars will no longer shine. **16** The LORD's voice will roar from Zion and thunder from Jerusalem, and the heavens and the earth will

shake. But the LORD will be a refuge for his people, a strong fortress for the people of Israel. **17** ‘Then you will know that I, the LORD your God, live in Zion, my holy mountain. Jerusalem will be holy forever, and foreign armies will never conquer her again.’”

Multitudes in the Valley of Decision



“This message concerning the fate of Israel came from the LORD: ‘This message is from the LORD, who stretched out the heavens, laid the foundations of the earth, and formed the human spirit. **2** I will make Jerusalem like an intoxicating drink that makes the nearby nations stagger when they send their armies to besiege Jerusalem and Judah. **3** On that day I will make Jerusalem an immovable rock. All the nations will gather against it to try to move it, but they will only hurt themselves. **4** ‘On

Zechariah 12:1-9 (NLT)

that day,' says the LORD, 'I will cause every horse to panic and every rider to lose his nerve. I will watch over the people of Judah, but I will blind all the horses of their enemies. **5** And the clans of Judah will say to themselves, 'The people of Jerusalem have found strength in the LORD of Heaven's Armies, their God.' **6** 'On that day I will make the clans of Judah like a flame that sets a woodpile ablaze or like a burning torch among sheaves of grain. They will burn up all the

neighboring nations right and left, while the people living in Jerusalem remain secure. **7** 'The LORD will give victory to the rest of Judah first, before Jerusalem, so that the people of Jerusalem and the royal line of David will not have greater honor than the rest of Judah. **8** On that day the LORD will defend the people of Jerusalem; the weakest among them will be as mighty as King David! And the royal descendants will be like God, like the angel of the LORD who goes before them! **9** For on

that day I will begin to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.”
