Not Just About ASKING:

- Ask, "Lord, is this YOUR will?"
- Make sure your MOTIVES are right
- Be OPEN to hear whatever He has to say to you



4. Search God's Word to Know His Will

"During this time, when about 120 believers were together in one place, Peter stood up and addressed them. 16 'Brothers,' he said, 'the Scriptures had to be fulfilled concerning Judas, who guided those who arrested Jesus. This was predicted long ago by the Holy Spirit, speaking through King David. 17 Judas was one of us and shared in the ministry with us.' 18 (Judas had bought a field with the money he received for his

treachery. Falling headfirst there, his body split open, spilling out all his intestines. 19 The news of his death spread to all the people of Jerusalem, and they gave the place the Aramaic name Akeldama, which means "Field of Blood.") 20 Peter continued, 'This was written in the book of Psalms, where it says, 'Let his home become desolate, with no one living in it.' It also says, 'Let someone else take his position.'"



Be Attentive to the RHEMA WORD





Rhema

- (Greek) = "utterance"
- When God takes His LOGOS ("written Word") and makes it RHEMA to speak to your situation

Proverbs 18:22 (NKJV) — "He who finds a wife finds a good thing, And obtains favor from the LORD."



5. Trust God to Guide You

Acts 1:23–26 (NKJV) — "And they proposed two: Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias. 24 And they prayed and said, 'You, O Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which of these two You have chosen 25 to take part in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas by transgression fell, that he might go to his own place." 26 And they cast their lots, and the lot fell on Matthias. And he was numbered with the eleven apostles."

fasting

- Separating yourself unto the Lord
- Denying fleshly desires
- Quieting all other voices
- **GOAL** = to hear God's voice



7. Seek Counsel from Spiritually Mature Believers

Proverbs 12:15 (NKJV) — The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, But he who heeds counsel is wise."

Proverbs 11:14 (NKJV) — "Where there is no counsel, the people fall; But in the multitude of counselors there is safety."

Proverbs 19:20–21 (ESV) — "Listen to advice and accept instruction, that you may gain wisdom in the future. **21 Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the LORD that will stand."**
