“When the Lamb broke the seventh seal on the scroll, there was **silence throughout heaven for about half an hour**. **2** I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and they were given seven trumpets. **3** Then another angel with a gold incense burner came and stood at the altar. And a great amount of incense was given to him to mix with the prayers of God’s people as an offering on the gold altar before the throne. **4** The smoke of the incense, mixed with the prayers of God’s holy people,

ascended up to God from the altar where the angel had poured them out. **5** Then the angel filled the incense burner with fire from the altar and threw it down upon the earth; and thunder crashed, lightning flashed, and there was a terrible earthquake. **6 Then the seven angels with the seven trumpets prepared to blow their mighty blasts.”**

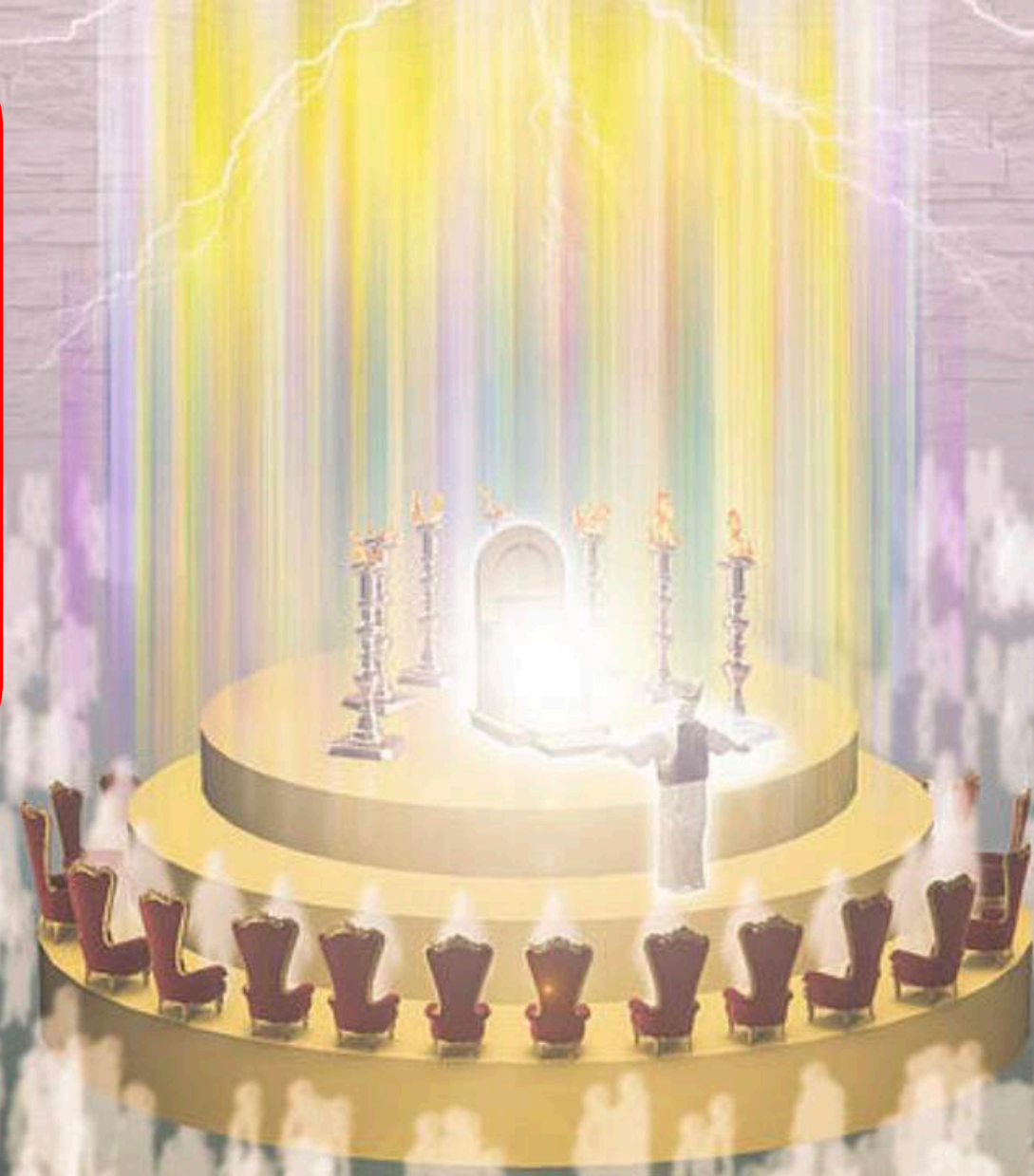

The Four Living Creatures

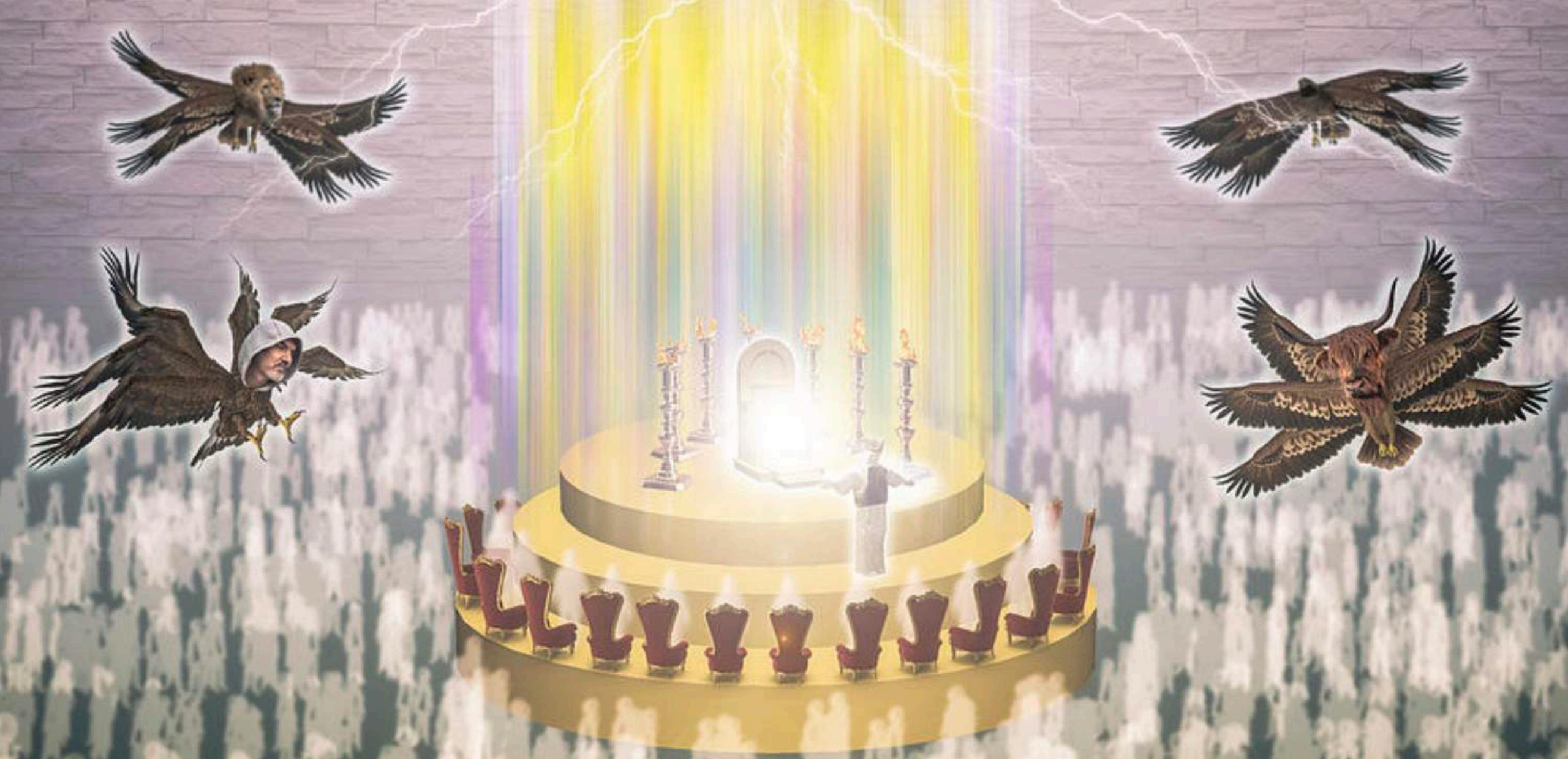
Revelation 4:8 (NLT) —“Each of these living beings had six wings, and their wings were covered all over with eyes, inside and out. **Day after day and night after night they keep on saying, ‘Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God, the Almighty— the one who always was, who is, and who is still to come.’”**



The Twenty-Four Elders

Revelation 4:10–11 (NLT) — “...the twenty-four elders fall down and worship the one sitting on the throne (the one who lives forever and ever). And they lay their crowns before the throne and say, **11** ‘You are worthy, O Lord our God, to receive glory and honor and power. For you created all things, and they exist because you created what you pleased.’”

Revelation 5:8–10 (NLT) — “And when He took the scroll, the four living beings and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each one had a harp, and they held gold bowls filled with incense, which are the prayers of God’s people. **9** And they sang a new song with these words: ‘You are worthy to take the scroll and break its seals and open it. For you were slaughtered, and your blood has ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation. **10** And you have caused them to become a Kingdom of priests for our God. And they will reign on the earth.’”

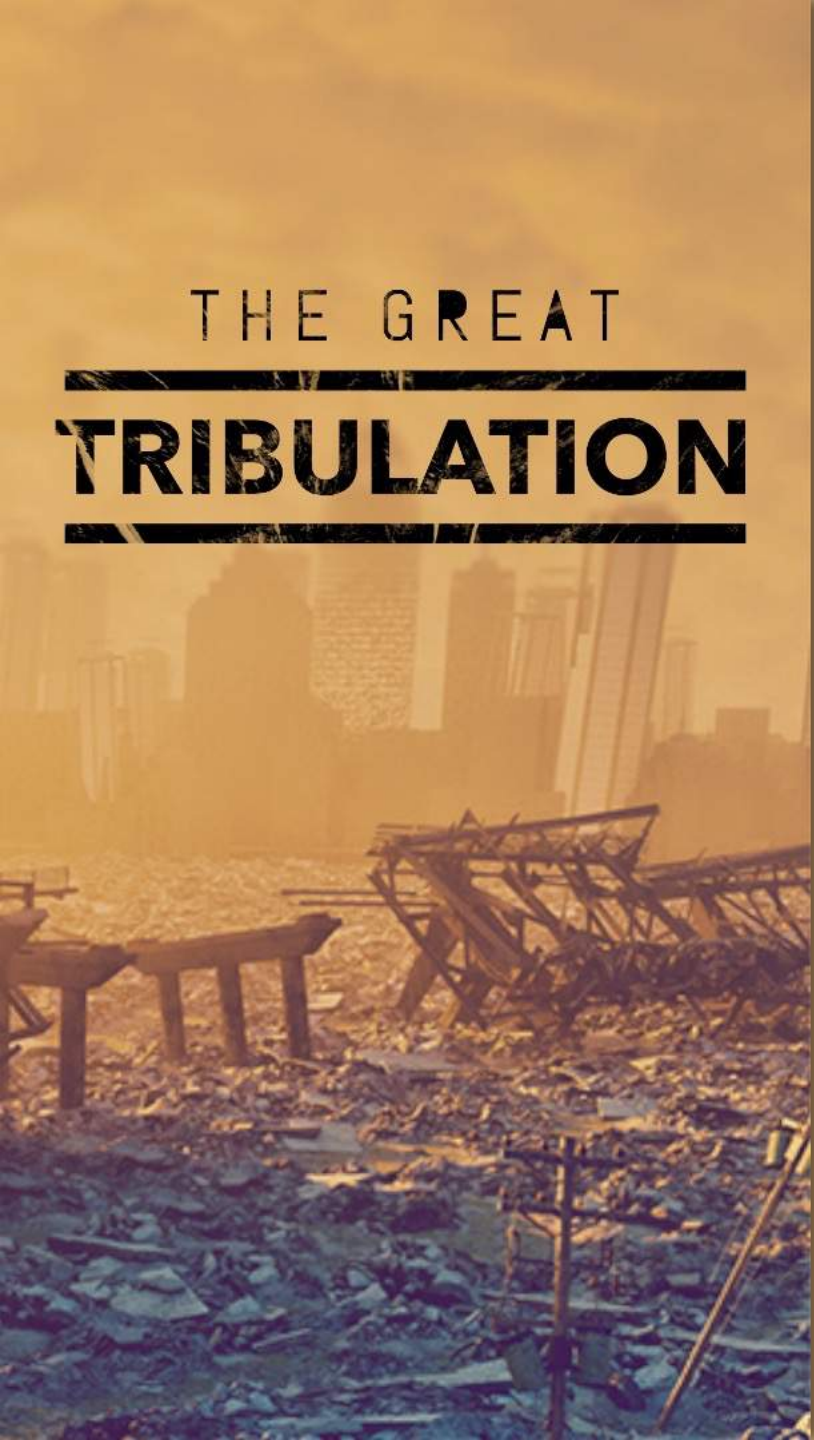

Exodus 9:23–26 (NLT) — “So Moses lifted his staff toward the sky, and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and lightning flashed toward the earth. The LORD sent a tremendous hailstorm against all the land of Egypt. **24** Never in all the history of Egypt had there been a storm like that, with such devastating hail and continuous lightning. **25** It left all of Egypt in ruins. The hail struck down everything in the open field—people, animals, and plants alike. Even the trees were destroyed. **26** The only place without hail was the region of Goshen, where the people of Israel lived.”

Genesis 19:24 (NLT) — “Then the LORD **rained down fire and burning sulfur from the sky on Sodom and Gomorrah.”**

Genesis 19:28 (NLT) — “He looked out across the plain toward Sodom and Gomorrah and watched as columns of smoke rose from the cities like smoke from a furnace.”

Joel 2:30–31 (NLT) — “And I will cause wonders in the heavens and on the earth— blood and fire and columns of smoke. **31** The sun will become dark, and the moon will turn blood red before that great and terrible day of the LORD arrives.”



Isaiah 28:17 (NLT) — “I will test you with the measuring line of justice and the plumb line of righteousness. Since your refuge is made of lies, a hailstorm will knock it down. Since it is made of deception, a flood will sweep it away.”

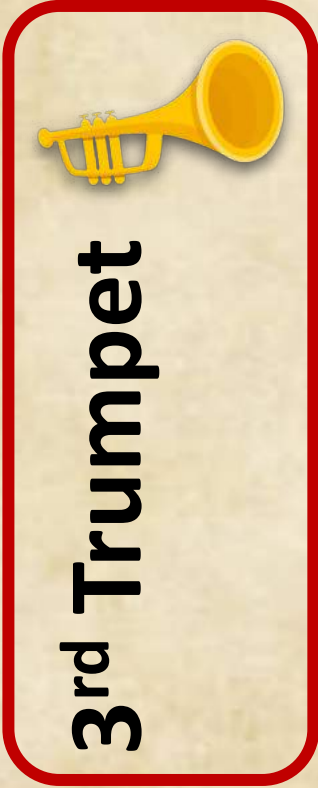

“Then the fifth angel blew his trumpet, and I saw **a star that had fallen to earth from the sky**, and **he was given the key to the shaft of the bottomless pit**. **2** When he opened it, smoke poured out as though from a huge furnace, and the sunlight and air turned dark from the smoke. **3 Then locusts came** from the smoke and descended on the earth, and they were given power to sting like scorpions. **4** They were told not to harm the grass or plants or trees, but only the people who did not

Revelation 9:1-12 (NLT)

have the seal of God on their foreheads. **5** They were told not to kill them but to torture them for five months with pain like the pain of a scorpion sting. **6 In those days people will seek death but will not find it. They will long to die, but death will flee from them!** **7** The locusts looked like horses prepared for battle. They had what looked like gold crowns on their heads, and their faces looked like human faces. **8** They had hair like women's hair and teeth like the teeth of a lion. **9** They

wore armor made of iron, and their wings roared like an army of chariots rushing into battle. **10** They had tails that stung like scorpions, and for five months they had the power to torment people. **11 Their king is the angel from the bottomless pit; his name in Hebrew is Abaddon, and in Greek, Apollyon—the Destroyer. 12** The first terror is past, but look, two more terrors are coming!”

Romans 8:38–39 (NLT) — “**And I am convinced** that nothing can ever separate us from God’s love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God’s love. **39** No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Galatians 2:20 (NKJV) — “I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.”
