### CLASS 3:

“You Shall Receive Power”

#### A. John 14:17 NKJV

**“the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.”**

Jesus when teaching on the Holy Spirit reveals that there is a two fold working of the Spirit available to every believer!

- First, there is the Spirit that abides through the “New Birth”
- Then there is a second work of that same Spirit that imparts an empowerment

#### B. John 20:19-22 NKJV

**“Then, the same day at evening, being the first *day* of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, “Peace *be* with you.” When He had said this, He showed them *His* hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. So Jesus said to them again, “Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you.” And when He had said this, He breathed on *them*, and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. These are the first human beings to receive the new birth.**

- **Acts 1:4 NKJV**

**And being assembled together with *them*, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” *He said*, “you have heard from Me;**

Jesus commands believers to receive this second fold working of the Holy Spirit which the believer receives in a baptismal measure. Jesus had a “full measure” we receive a baptismal measure.

**John 3:24 NKJV “For John had not yet been thrown into prison.”**

- #### C. With an understanding of the New Birth together with the infilling of the Holy Spirit, God has supplied the believer unmeasured power both inward and outward. It is our responsibility to grow in the truths and to live a life “in the Spirit” controlled and empowered by God Almighty to the benefit of all that choose to believe. God’s power is supernatural and available to every “whosoever will ” that dares to step out in faith on the truths of God’s Word.
