Goal 1: Call an associate pastor by the end of 2023.

READ: Ephesians 4:11-12 "And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, ¹²to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ"

Goal 2: Hire a full-time staff person to oversee Family Ministry by March 2023

READ: Deuteronomy 6:4-9 "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. ⁵You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."

Goal 3: Develop an annual Outreach plan and present to the congregation by January 2023.

READ: Matthew 28:19-20 "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Goal 4: By March 2023, form a team to have regular fellowship events at least quarterly.

READ: Acts 2:42 "And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers."

READ: 1 Corinthians 1:9 "God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. "

Q: According to 1 Corinthians 1:9, what did God call us into? What does this means and why is it important?

Goal 5: Develop opportunities for the Elders to build relationships with their Shepherd's Lists by June 2023.

READ: 1 Timothy 5:17 " Let the elders who rule well be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in preaching and teaching."
