<b>Daniel -</b> "God is my judge"	<b>Belteshazzar -</b> <i>"Bel protect his life"</i> - Bel was the name of a Babylonian god	
<b>Hananiah -</b> "Jehovah is gracious"	<b>Shadrach -</b> <i>"The command of the moon god" -</i> a Babylonian god	
Mishael - "Who is like God?"	Meshach - "Who is like Aku" - one of the heathen gods	
<b>Azariah -</b> "Jehovah is my helper"	Abed-nego - "The servant of Nego" - another heathen god
