 - i. Our scripture calls him Levi
 - 1. He was a levite
 - Role of Levites to serve in the house of the Lord; He was serving
 Rome
 - 3. Jesus calls him to follow him, learn from him, and serve God
 - c. Pharisees
 - i. Who they were Maccabbean revolt
 - ii. Their goal guard God's ways (slide); added additional guard rails beyond what God had asked, creating a new system
 - iii. Name means separate attempted to separate from all Gentiles likepriests
 - iv. Focused so much on not breaking the law that they missed connecting relationally with others
 - v. Many were quite sincere. Many thought they were doing what was right.

- vi. Challenge: Who fits in your pharisee box? Who do you shun or exclude as you are judging their intentions, motivations, and actions?
- d. Sinners "those who are sick"
 - i. Low status people sinners, tax collectors, people who are misfits
 - ii. High status people pharisees, scribes, rabbis

 - b. Befriending them, like Matthew
 - c. Like the President flying in to Madison, going to peace park and talking the homeless, and then leaving without meeting with the Mayor or Governor

 - ii. For example, an alcoholic shouldn't go into a bar with people who are drinking. That would be sin. But the person can be friend an alcoholic.
