

Like Jesus Communion

Luke 22:14-20

"When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. And he said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God." After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, "Take this and divide it among you. For I tell you I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you."

Spend a few moments considering these questions...

- Can you remember what it was like when you met Jesus for the first time or the moment you first heard about him?
- What was your life like at that time?
- Why did you feel like you needed a Savior?
- What was it about Jesus that caused you to place your faith in Him?
- How has your love and affection for Jesus grown since the moment you originally met Him?
- When considering Jesus' death, the way that He died, the torment that He faced on your behalf, carrying the weight of your sin so that you wouldn't have to, what feelings or thoughts come to mind?

Jesus challenged us in the verse above to take time out of our schedules to remember Him - to remember the sacrifices He made on our behalf. His body was broken, crushed, for you. His blood was poured out for us. He did all of that because He loves us. That is pretty incredible love. **How does this make you feel?** Perhaps spend a minute sharing those feelings with Jesus.
