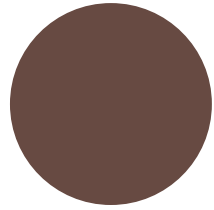
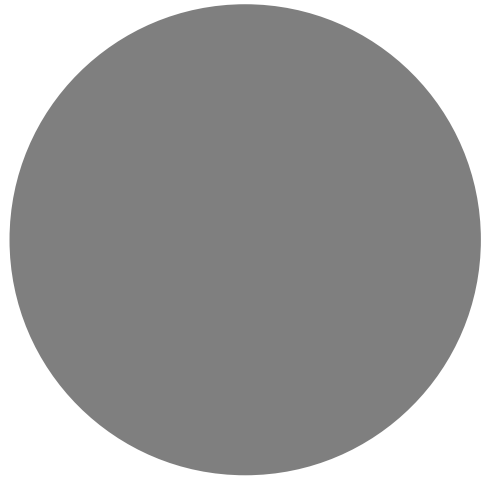

1. Promises of God: Still Work to Do


Reward: He is Our Strength

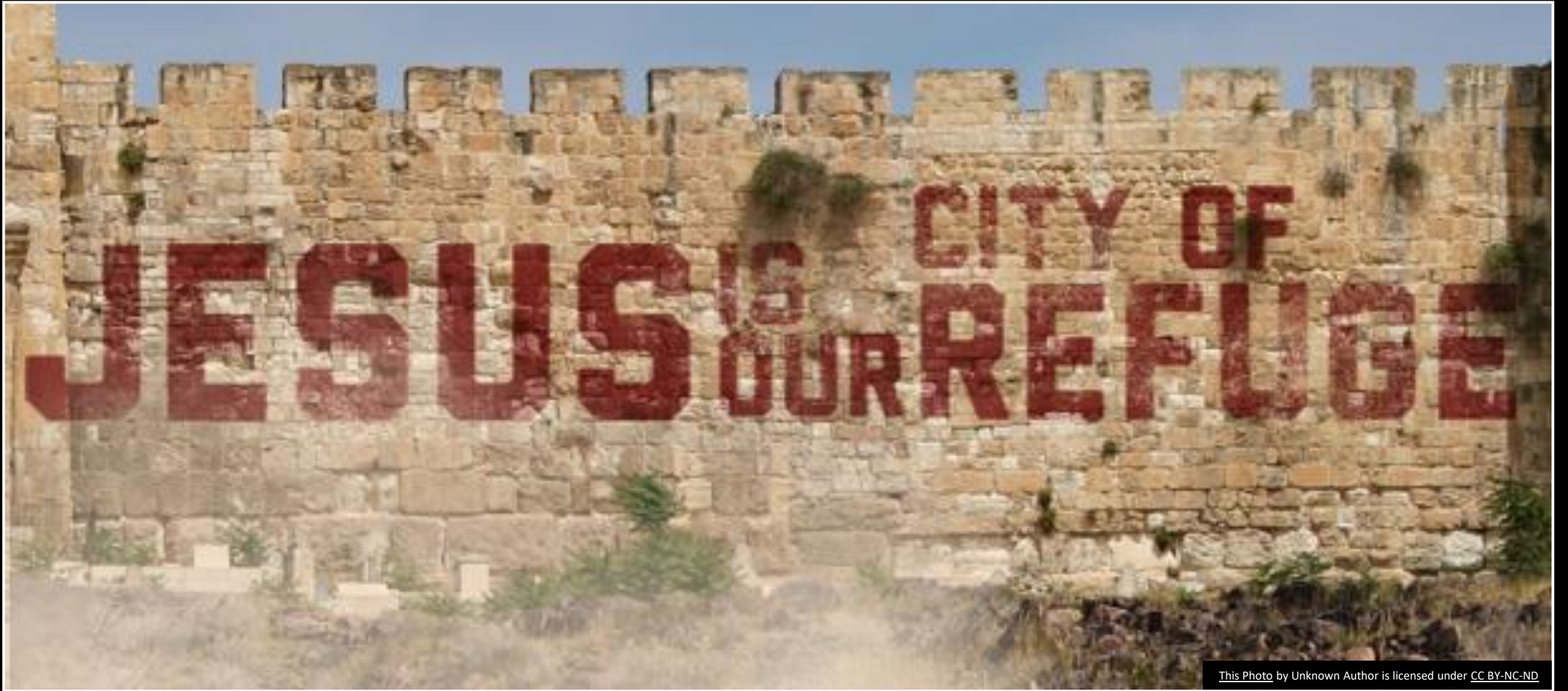
