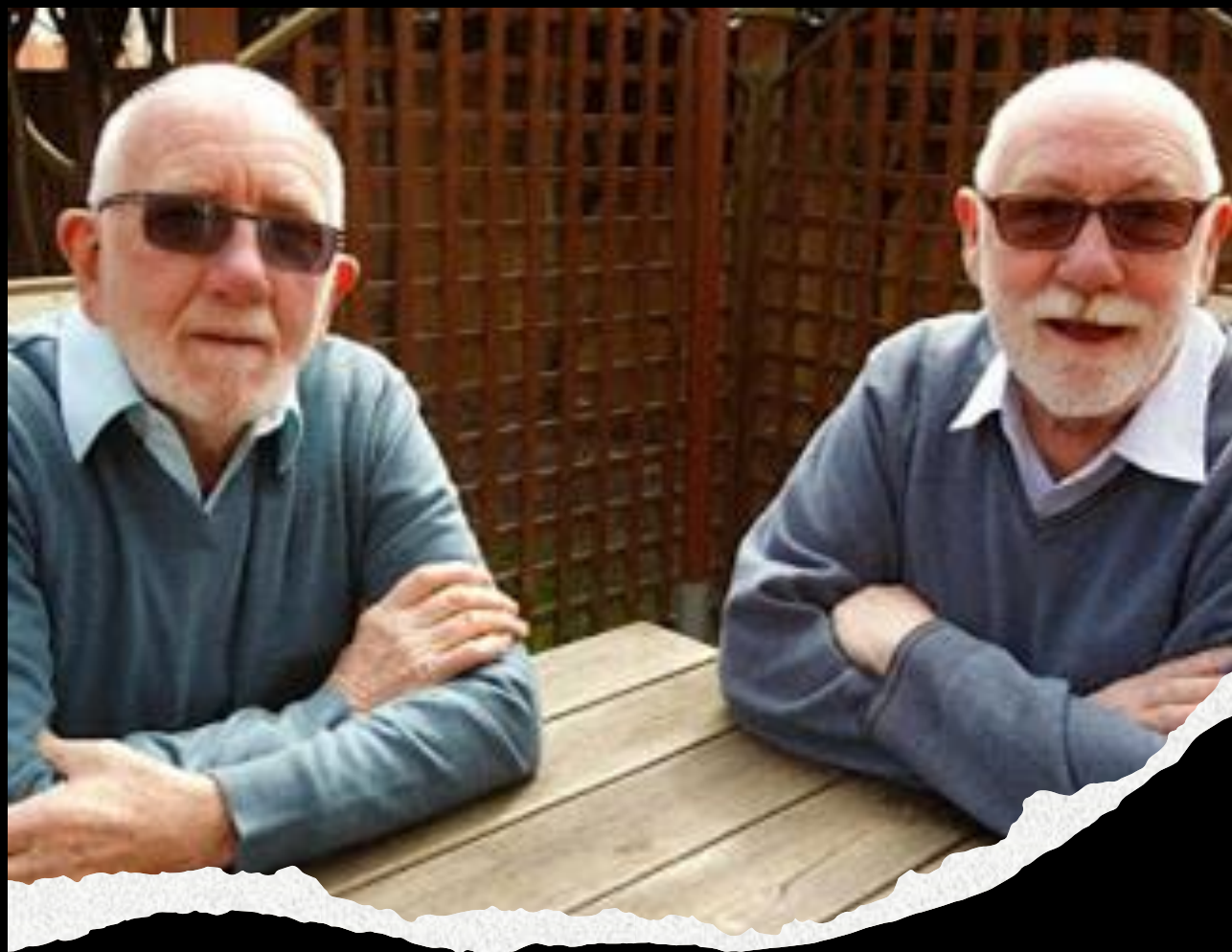

- 75% of all adolescent patients in youth substance abuse centers

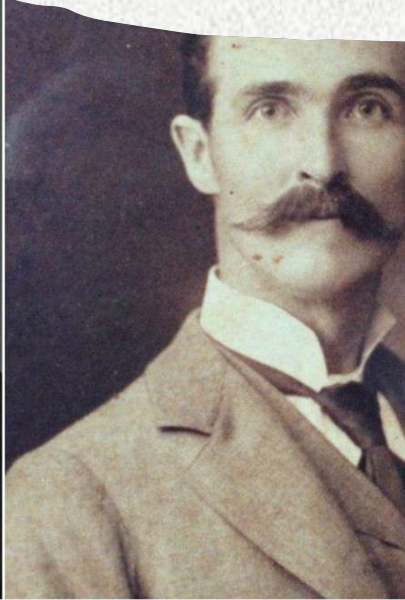
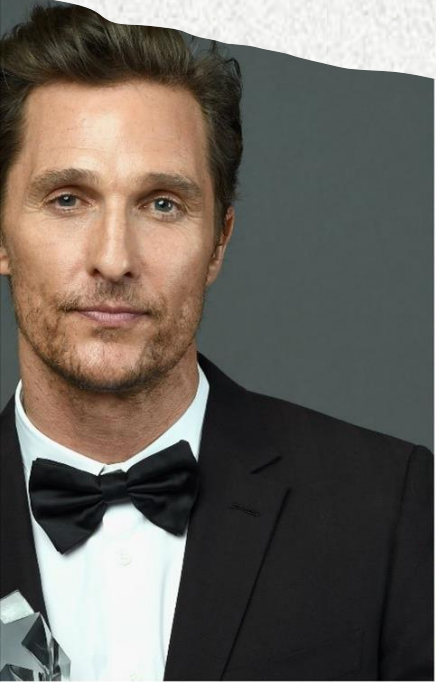


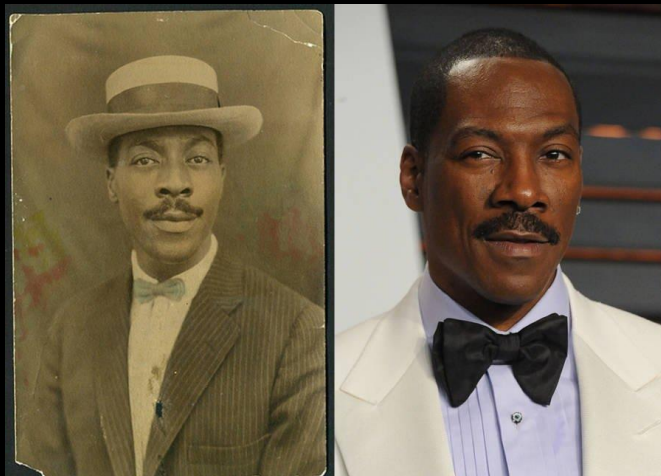
