## 2. Proclaimed by the Son



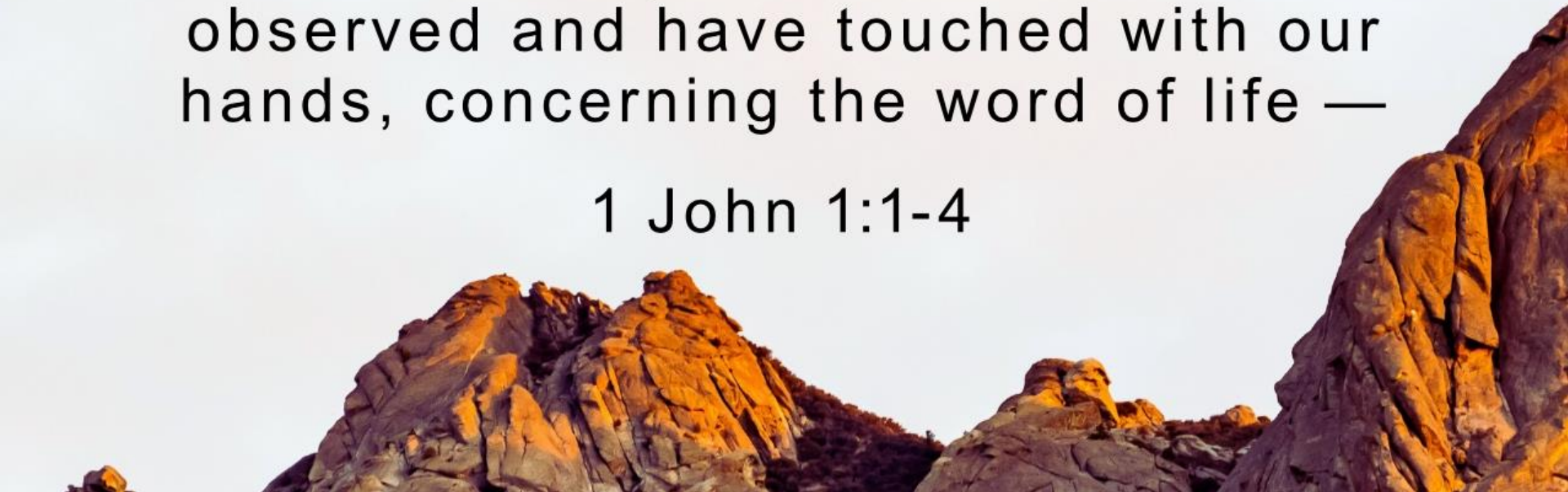
