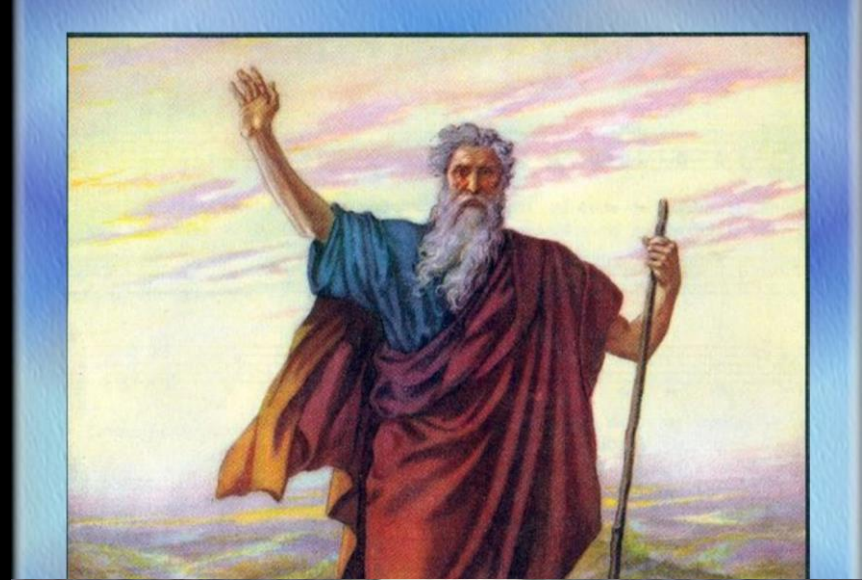

# ISAIAH 28:9-12

**“Who is he trying to teach? Who is he trying to instruct? Infants just weaned from milk? Babies removed from the breast? ‘Law after law, law after law, line after line, line after line, a little here, a little there.’ For he will speak to this people with stammering speech and in a foreign language. He had said to them, ‘This is the place of rest; let the weary rest; this is the place of repose.’ But they would not listen.”**

# **TONGUES: A SIGN – JUDGEMENT OR LIBERATION?**

**Sign of Liberation – The Gospel is intended for all nations, not just Jewish people**

**Sign of Judgement – The Jews that rejected Jesus now know that the Good News is offered to all nations**

# **3. THE SPEAKER'S AUDIENCE**

**”Speaking in tongues, then, is intended as a sign, not for believers but for unbelievers, while prophecy is not for unbelievers but for believers. If, therefore, the whole church assembles together, and all are speaking in tongues and people who are outsiders or unbelievers come in, will they not say that you are out of your minds?”**

**1 Cor. 14:22-23**

**“But if all are prophesying and some unbeliever or outsider comes in, he is convicted by all and is called to account by all.”**
