


<sup>3</sup>The gatekeeper opens it for him,

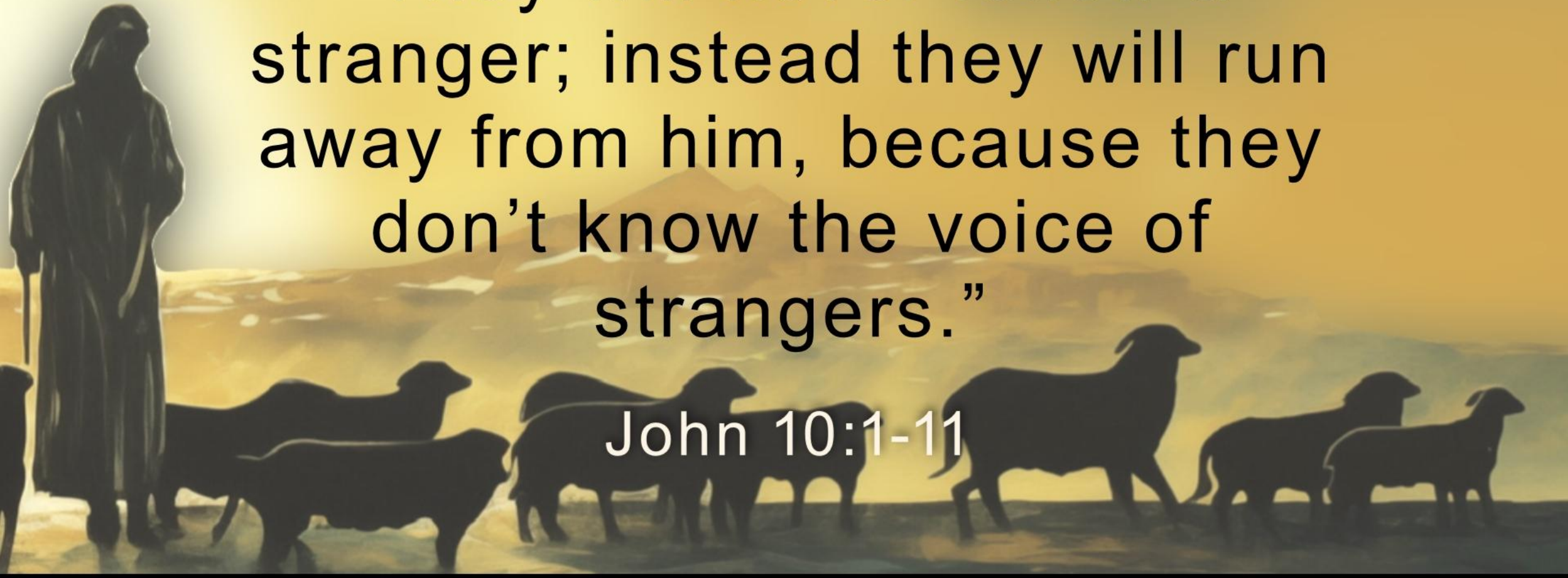
<sup>4</sup>When he has brought all his own outside, he goes ahead of them. The sheep follow him because they know his voice.

John 10:1-11

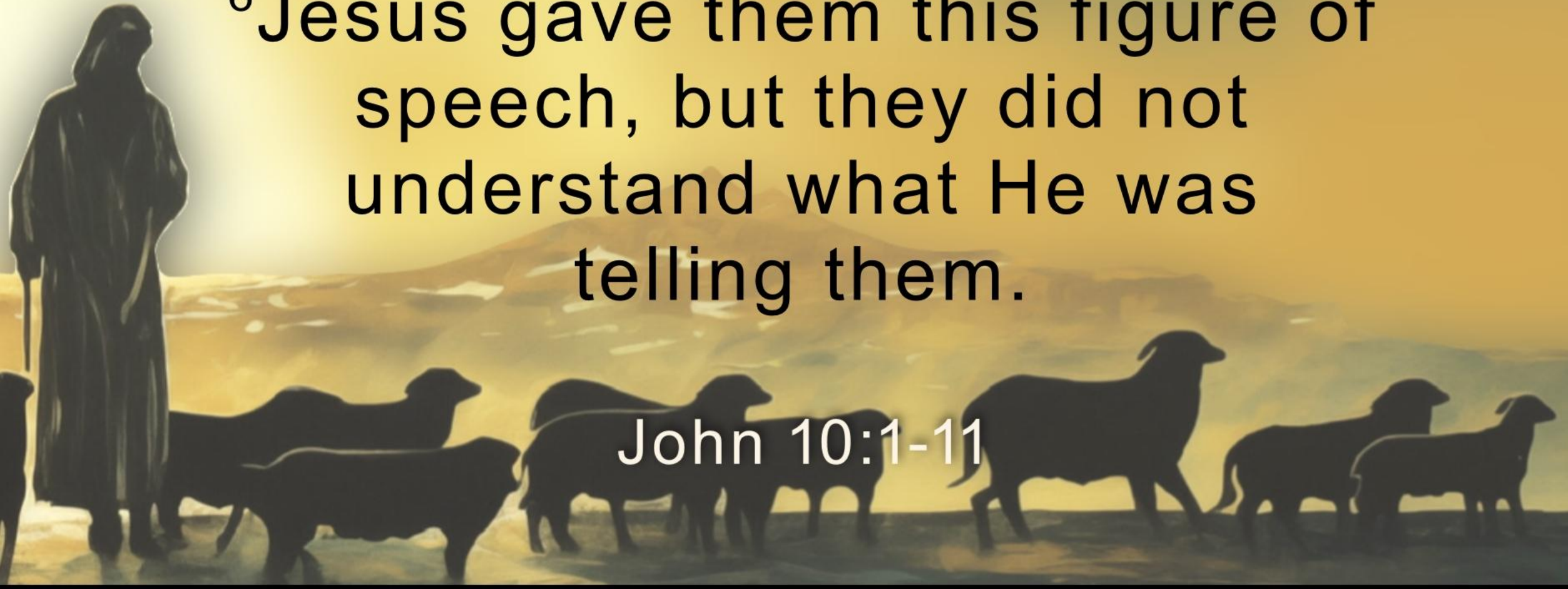

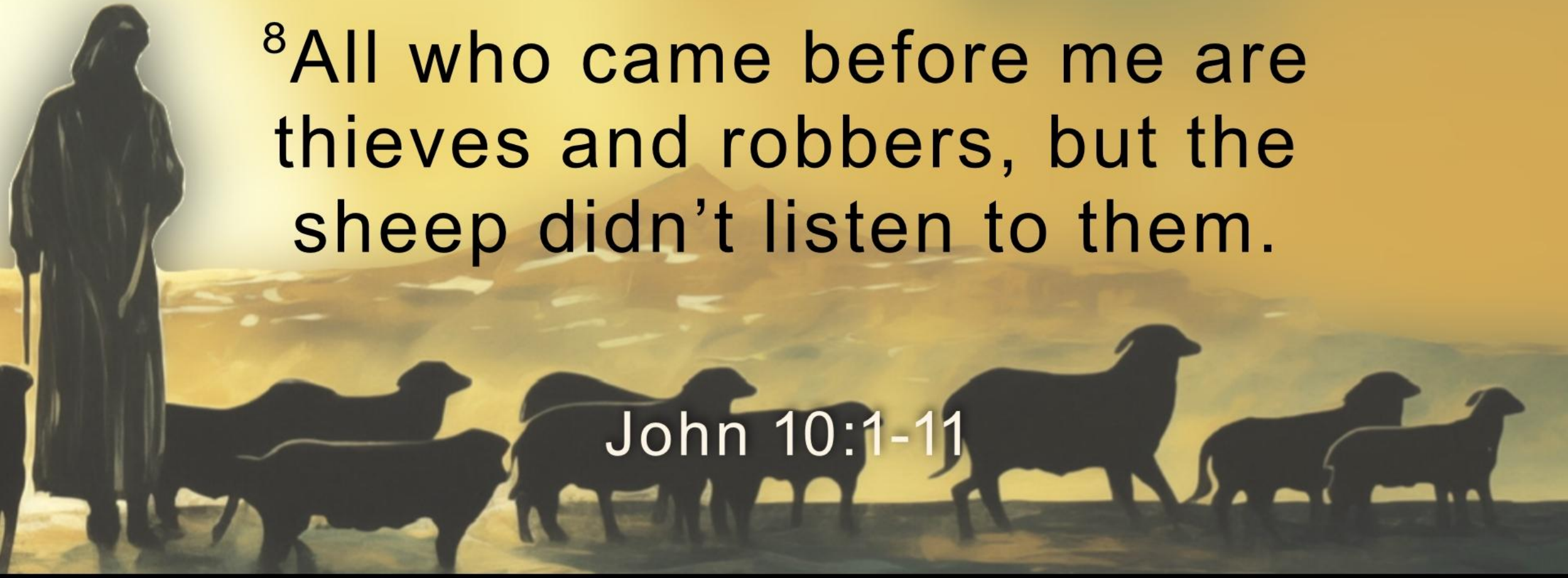

<sup>8</sup>All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep didn't listen to them.

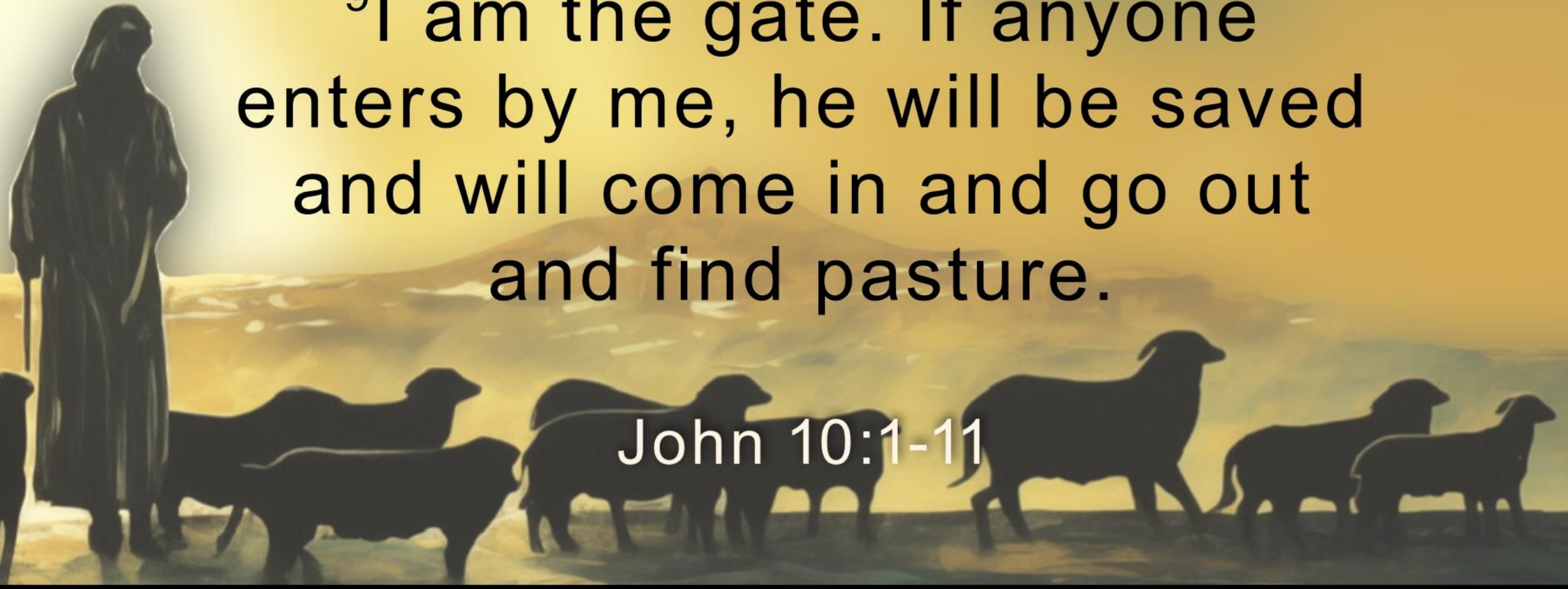

John 10:1-11

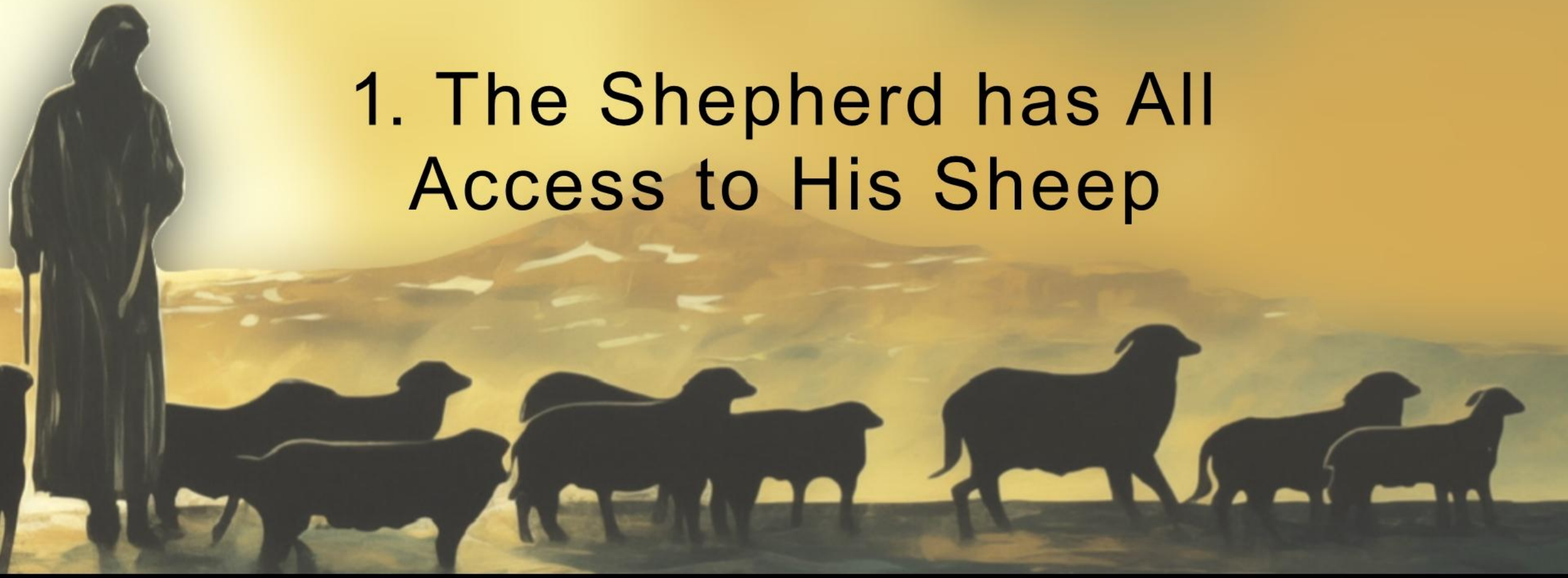

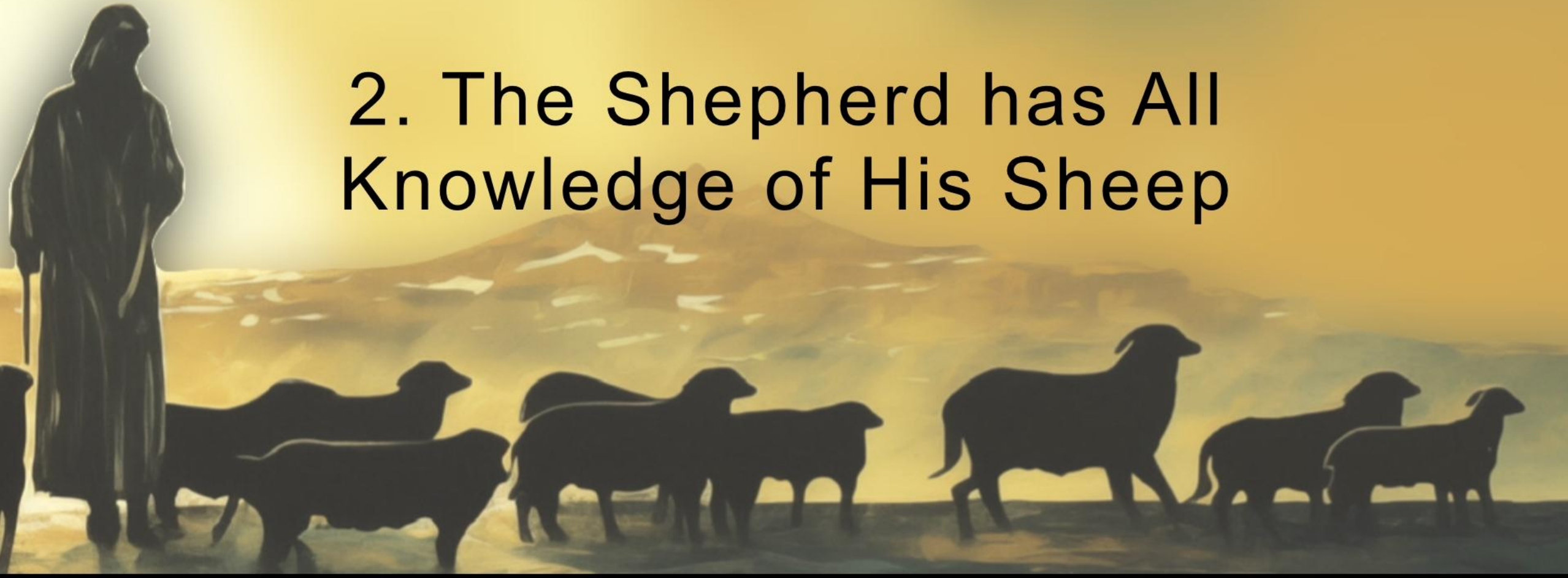
## 1. The Shepherd has All Access to His Sheep





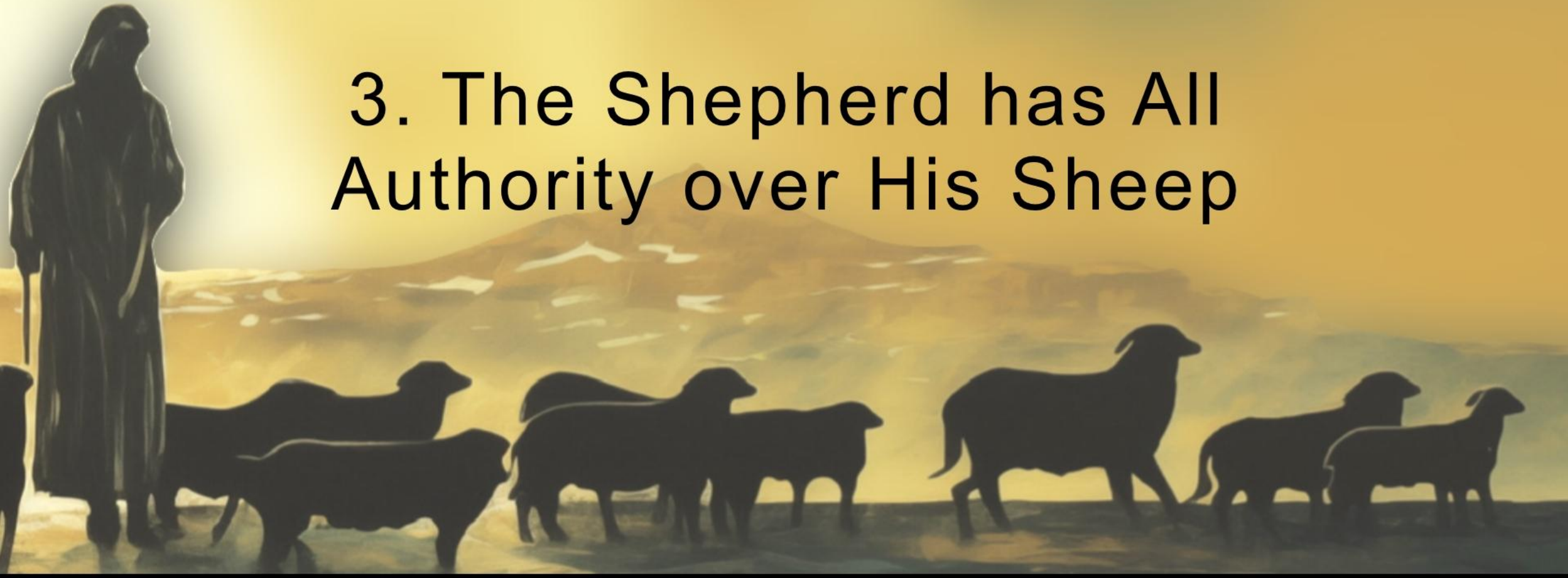

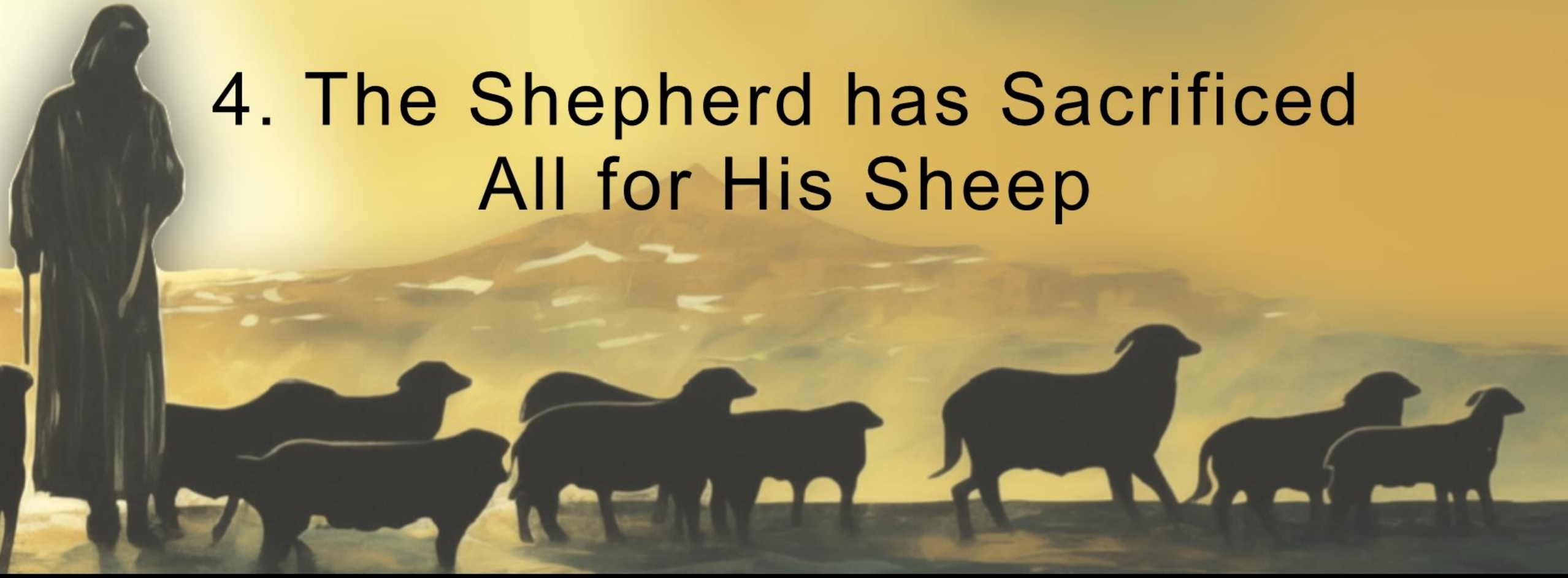
## 3. The Shepherd has All Authority over His Sheep
