Scripture Readings

Psalm 106:4-5; Psalm 106

Context

“Can a woman forget her suckling child that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb. Yea they may forget, yet i will not forget thee”. Isaiah 49:14-16

This is a desperate cry. Man can forget you but God cannot forget you.

Confession

“Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us”. Ephesians 3:20

- (7) Every dividing wall between me and my divine helpers break and fall in Jesus Name.
- (8) O Lord favour me and let me eat at the table of the Kings like Mephbosheth (2 Samuel 9:11).
- (9) Oh Lord by your mercy and favour take me from the position of nobody to the position of somebody before the end of this year.
- (10) Let your divine favour from the north, east, south, and west locate me in Jesus name.
- (11) Favour me O Lord and let me not experience suffering.
- (12) Exodus 3:21 says “And i shall give this people favour in the sight of the Egyptians and it shall come to pass that when ye go, ye shall not go empty”.
- (13) I decree and declare in my life that I shall not enter year 2018 empty in Jesus name.
- (14) As from today I receive the power to turn obstacles into miracles in Jesus name.

- (16) I close all doors through which the enemy has been working against me.
