## Group/Family/Personal Study Questions

1. Is there anyone you love so much you won't let them drift/wander? Explain.

2. What do plants and trees need in order to produce fruits or vegetables?

3. Why do farmers/orchardists cut, prune, thin, distress their plants/trees?

4. What are the ways God has cut, pruned, thinned you? Why did He do/allow that?

5. When Jesus said we can do nothing apart from Him, what did/does that mean?

6. Can you tell if someone is a Christian? What evidence is there of Christian faith?

7. What does it mean that Jesus calls us His friends? Describe several ways you know others love you? How have you loved others (friends, God, enemies) this past week?

## Reflection/Action:

Spend fifteen minutes in silence and prayer. Read through the passage (John 15:1-16) again. Can others see evidence of Christian faith in your life (Fruit)? Read Galatians 5:22-23. Do you see any of these "fruits" growing in your life? Why or why not?
