- 1. To stay focused the **trouble** on the way must be < the **prize** at the end 2 Timothy 2:3, 2 Corinthians 4:16-18
- 2. To stay focused the <u>one we seek to please</u> must be > than the <u>noise</u> around us 2 Timothy 2:4, John 6:66-69
- 3. To stay focused doing **what is right** must be > than the **shortcuts** in front to us 2 Timothy 2:5-7, Matthew 4:8-10

- **5.** Why do some take shortcuts in life knowing they are sacrificing their integrity & character? What are some shortcuts people take as Christians?
- **6.** Share 3 or 4 ways you stay focused on what is most important in your life & faith.
