- 2. What internal anguish did Jesus feel, grappling with the reality that Judas would sell Him out? That Peter would repeatedly deny even knowing Him?
- 3. How do you think both Judas and Peter got to point where they could actually do the things they did?
- 4. How do you respond when you realize that you have betrayed or denied Jesus?
- 5. When you fail, how do you respond? Self-reliance? Or, honest acceptance of the costly grace, mercy and forgiveness of Jesus Christ?
