3. What about having a New Identity, a New Perspective, and a True Calling changes the way you view your work? Which of these three areas stretches you the most?
4. From the very beginning, according to God's own activity, there is a rhythm – a time to speak/work and a time to be silent/rest. How is this reflected in your life? Have you incorporated 'rest' into your weekly schedule? Do you need to?
5. In what ways do you/have you define(d) yourself by your vocation? Why is it that ultimately this is unsatisfying?
