Paul's Calling**• Galatians 1:11-14**

- Paul was transformed from a Jewish zealot to servant of Christ

God's Work & Paul's Confirmation**• Galatians 1:15-2:3**

- After His calling, God worked through Paul with Evidence
 - When God works, He is glorified
- Paul's Timeline - To set up that his revelation of the gospel was from God and not influenced by the Apostles
 - Confirmation that it was God that worked in Paul

Story #1 - False Teachers**• Galatians 2:4-10**

- "to make us slaves" - The law was oppressive and binding to those that were under it but in Christ we are released from it - **Romans 7:1-6**

• The Gospel is not a malleable abstract concept

- It is new life in Christ and love for Him as Lord

• Galatians 2:7-10

- Paul recognized as the same as Peter but to the Gentiles

Story #2 - Rebuke of Peter**• Galatians 2:11-14**

- God's mercy extended in salvation was poured out inclusively
 - Salvation to Jew and Gentile without distinction
 - Making them one people in Christ

To the Church in Galatia:

- The church failed to protect and conceded
- Failed to call out the distortion of the gospel

The Message of the Gospel requires preservation

- Because the gospel is transformative

The work of God

- God calls
- God confirms with wise counsel
- God works with evidence
- God's truth prevails
- God is Glorified
