**The Gospel message is of the utmost importance,
for what we know and how we live**

Galatians 1:1-5

- “Grace and Peace” = Summary of The Gospel
- Jewish History separation - present age and Coming Age

Galatians 1:6-8

- “Some will trouble you”- They will bring you harm
- Test the Spirits - 1 John 4:1-6
 - 1) The message must confirm that Jesus came in the flesh
 - Confirmation of His dual nature (Fully God and Fully Man)
 - 2) The Holy Spirit will reveal the Truth
 - John 16:13 - The Spirit of Truth
 - The Gospel will prevail over falsehood
 - **The Gospel will reflect the relationship that exists between Father, Son and Holy Spirit**

Galatians 1:8

- Another “Apostle”
- “Divine” Being
- They are accursed = anathema - Put under God’s Judgement
 - Revelation 22:18-19

Galatians 1:9

- Repeated to emphasize the severity and the consequences

Galatians 1:10

- Pleasing God (Servant of Christ)
 - Selfless life
 - Constant battle against our sinful desires (Flesh)
 - It is in opposition of the rest of the world
- Pleasing Man (Attempt that is never satisfied)
 - Self focused - what do I want/desire
 - Allows for the indulgence of the flesh (no conflict)
 - It is in alignment with the world (God is the enemy)

The Truth is Objective

- We must separate what is True from what is False

1. We must apply what we know to be true to how we live

Application

2. Be uncompromised in that Truth despite opposition

Boldness

With Truth there is no compromise
