The Redeemer shifts our mentality on life

Micah 7:1-4

- Briers and Thorn Hedges
 - They are undesirable
 - Luke 6:44 - Trees are known by their fruit
 - Good fruit cannot be gathered from the best of Israel
- The watchman looks for calamity

Micah 7:8-10

- God's discipline is justified
 - Court has been held and Israel has been found guilty (ch6)
 - After their discipline Israel's enemies will see the mighty God

Micah 6:11-20

- God will keep his promises
 - Covenant with Israel (they will be made into a great nation again)
 - New covenant (Christ has established the eternal kingdom that will last for eternity 2 Sam 7)

The Testimony of God's steadfast Love

- God's wrath against sin is building
- Christ's death satisfied the wrath of God as the atonement for sin
- Through Christ we are delivered into Paradise for all eternity

This was accomplished in CHRIST

The Believer's Mindset

- Everything is a righteous act of God to protect guide and lead his people to salvation
 - When his Justice is poured out, it is him teaching us to be more like him
 - When he pardons sin (Through Christ), it is an act of his Mercy removing what we deserve to experience his incredible forgiveness
