

## 2 Timothy 2:15-17a

His word is nourishing Bread, meant to sustain life

**God's word**

- it is meant to equip us with passion, wisdom, strength, safety and security

**Biblical Inerrancy**

- God's word is without error
- The only interpretation is God's interpretation

**Developing Context**

- Context cannot be used to negate God's word
  - 1 Timothy 2:12 - do not permit a woman to teach
    - Paul called out false teachers and it wasn't about education
    - Context - 1 Timothy 2:13-14 = its about system of creation

**Let Scripture define itself**

- Matthew 13 - parables
  - v1-9 - Parable of the Sower = v18-23 - Explanation
  - v24-30 - Parable of the Weeds = v36-43 - Explanation
- Melchizedek
  - Genesis 14:18-20 - Random Encounter/Random Person
  - Hebrews 5:10 - Christ appearing to Abraham

**Sola Scriptura**

- Martin Luther 95 Theses
  - 5 solas (Scripture, Faith, Grace, Christ, God's glory)
- Sola Scriptura = By Scripture Alone
  - Supreme Authority of Scripture
    - Anything presented in the world as truth, must be validated by Scripture
    - 2 Timothy 3:14-17 = The potential of Scripture

**Scripture**

- Matthew 4:4 - Meant to sustain Life
- Ephesians 4:11-15 - Defense against falsehood
  - Hebrews 5:11-14 - Brings believers to spiritual maturity

Reading God's word is a desire for life, not spiritual discipline
