

2 Thessalonians 1:1-12

We are found worthy of the Kingdom

2 Thessalonians 1:1-5

- God Promises in trials
 - We are promised trouble (Jn 16:33), we are promised discipline (Prov 3:12, Heb 12:6).
 - We are also promised peace (Phil 4:7), strength (Isa 41:10), wisdom (Jms 1:5) and power (2 Tim 1:7)
- **Both promises are true simultaneously**

2 Thessalonians 1:6-9

- The Gospel
 - The good news of salvation through the work of Christ (Life, Death and Resurrection) that makes relationship with God possible
- The Final Judgement
 - **God honoring the choice that we made in this life to live apart from him**

2 Thessalonians 1:10-12

- Sanctification (Process of being conformed into the image of Christ)
 - It is the process of obedience and the spiritual work of God in believers through the Holy Spirit
