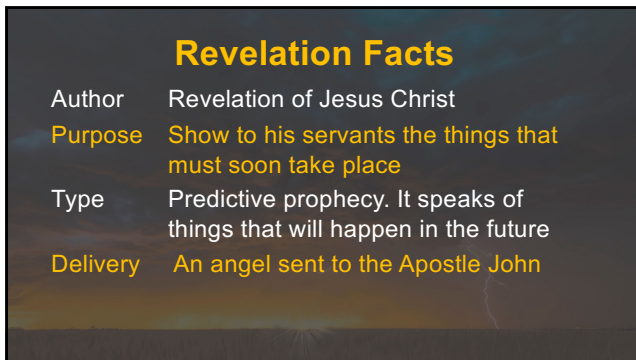
Revelation Facts

Author Revelation of Jesus Christ

Purpose Show to his servants the things that must soon take place

Type Predictive prophecy. It speaks of things that will happen in the future

Delivery An angel sent to the Apostle John

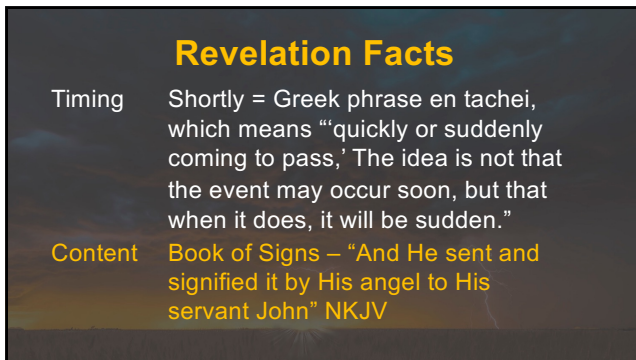

Revelation Facts

Timing Shortly = Greek phrase en tachei, which means "quickly or suddenly coming to pass," The idea is not that the event may occur soon, but that when it does, it will be sudden."

Content Book of Signs – "And He sent and signified it by His angel to His servant John" NKJV

Revelation 6

1 Now I watched when the Lamb opened one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures say with a voice like thunder, "Come!" 2 And I looked, and behold, a white horse! And its rider had a bow, and a crown was given to him, and he came out conquering, and to conquer.

Revelation 6

3 When he opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature say, "Come!" 4 And out came another horse, bright red. Its rider was permitted to take peace from the earth, so that people should slay one another, and he was given a great sword.

5 When he opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, "Come!" And I looked, and behold, a black horse! And its rider had a pair of scales in his hand.
