- Hiding, poor, weak, lame, and fearful before our King comes to us.


- Separated from our King because of our wicked ancestors

-Grants the privilege of provision at the King's table.


-Received as sons at the King's table, with access to the King and fellowship with Him.

- 4. Sheep who knows his shepherd



It is the glory of God to conceal things, but the glory of kings is to search things out.






