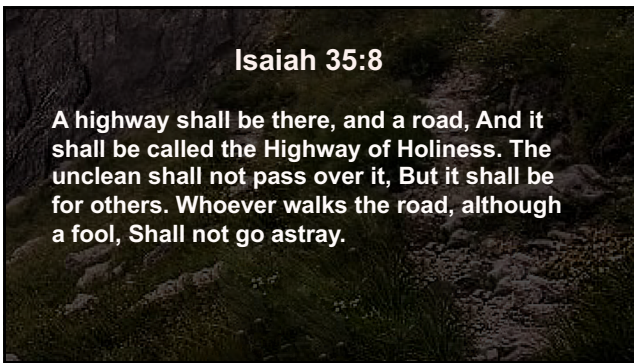

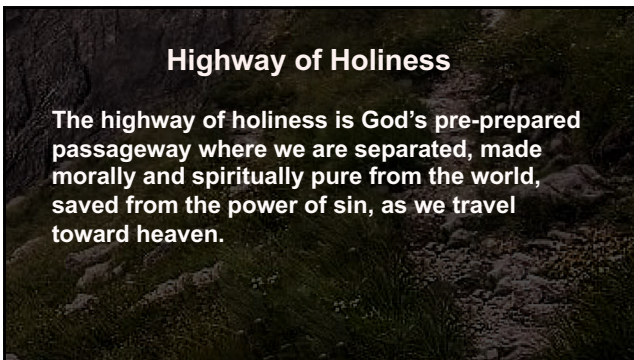

### Character is Supernaturally Fashioned
