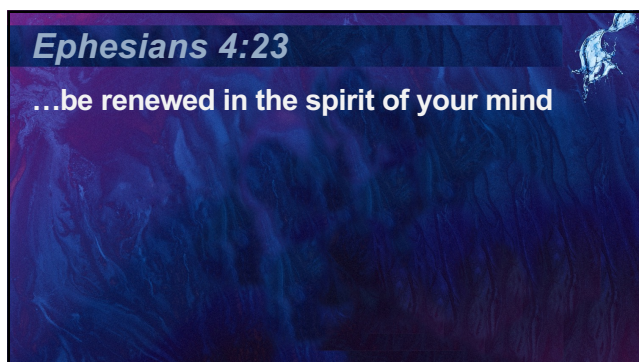
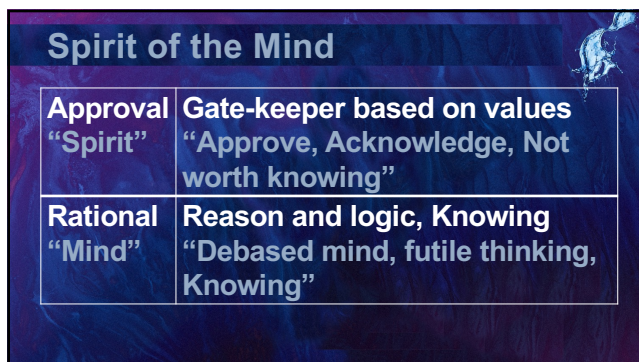

Confess (Greek)

Homologeō = "Same" + "Words"

1. to say the same thing as another
2. To admit or declare one's self guilty of what one is accused of
3. Profess: to declare openly, speak out freely

Confess (Hebrew)

Yada, Yadhah = to use (i.e. hold out) the hand; physically, to throw (a stone, an arrow) at or away; to praise (Judah), revere or worship (with extended hands); intensively, to bemoan (by wringing the hands)

Confess

An act to place one in harmony with others. It is the uniting in agreement with a statement that has previously been made by someone else

All Our Sins Are Already Forgiven

John 19:30 "It is finished,"

Col 2:13-14 13 And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, 14 by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross.

All Our Sins Are Already Forgiven

Hebrews 7:27 "[Christ] has no need, like those [Old Testament] high priests, to offer sacrifices daily . . . since he did this once for all when he offered up himself."

Hebrews 9:26 He has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself."

All Our Sins Are Already Forgiven

Hebrews 10:14 For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified."

1 John 1

8 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 'If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness'?

Purchase vs Possession

We must distinguish between the purchase and securing of our forgiveness at the death of Jesus from our personal possession and enjoyment of that benefit through faith in Christ.

Put On the Benefits of Being in Christ

New Creation	2 Cor 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.
Confess	"I am a new creation in Christ Jesus. The old has gone, the new has come"

Put On the Benefits of Being in Christ

Righteousness of Christ	2 Cor 5:21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
Confess	"I am the righteous of God in Christ Jesus. "

Put On the Benefits of Being in Christ

Complete	Col 2:10 and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.
Confess	"I am complete in Him and He loves the way he has made me, body, soul, and spirit."

Put On the Benefits of Being in Christ

Adopted Son	Ephesians 1:5 he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will
Confess	"I have been adopted into God's family and rejoice to do my Father's will"

Put On the Benefits of Being in Christ

Authority Over the Enemy	Luke 10:19 Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.
Confess	"I have authority over all the power of the enemy and nothing shall hurt me"

Put On the Benefits of Being in Christ

Spiritual Authority	Eph 2:6 and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,
Confess	"I am seated with Christ in heavenly places with all spiritual authority"

Put On the Benefits of Being in Christ

Healed	1 Peter 2:24 He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.
Confess	"I have been healed by the wounds of Jesus bore on the cross."
