David's Sons

Name	Mother	Result
Amnon	Ahinoam	Killed by Absalom after he raped Absalom's full sister, Tamar
Daniel	Abigail	No record of life, likely died young
Absalom	Maacah	Rebellion against David. Killed during civil war. Resented rape of his sister
Adonijah	Haggith	Rebellion against Solomon. Tried to marry David's concubine

Solomon	Bathsheba	Obsession with romance 700 Wives 300 Concubines

Lust wears us down

2 And Amnon was so tormented that he made himself ill

ILL = châlah, khaw-law'; to be rubbed or worn; hence (figuratively) to be weak, sick, afflicted

Amnon was

1. Physically attracted by her beauty
2. Emotionally attracted by her femininity
3. Socially attracted because she was a princess

But none of this is God's love

Greek	Definition
Eros	Romantic, sexual love
Storge	Familial affection – brother, sister, parents
Philia	Love of friendship, called brotherly love
Agape	God's perfect love. Covenant Love

Tormenting Yourself with Sin

Lust → tormenting-distressing themselves
