The redeemed shall walk there	No camel, horse, donkey. Only redeemed walkers



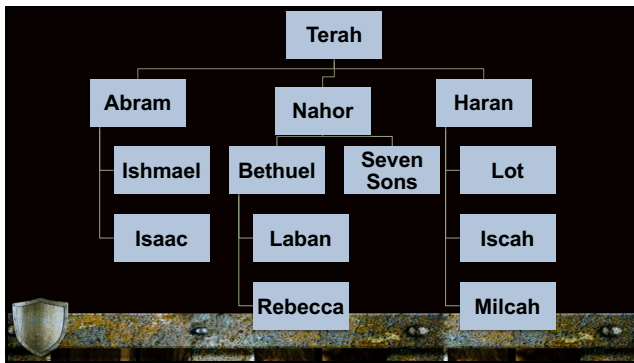


