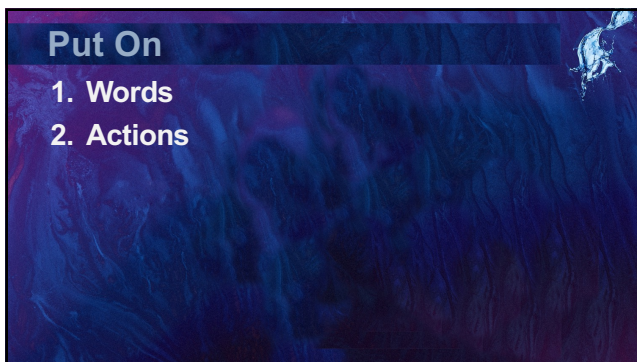
Presence and Power

God's presence and power goes with His Word. When God gives us His word, He is giving of Himself.

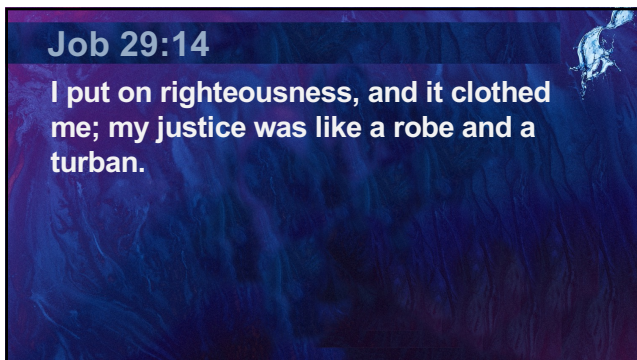
