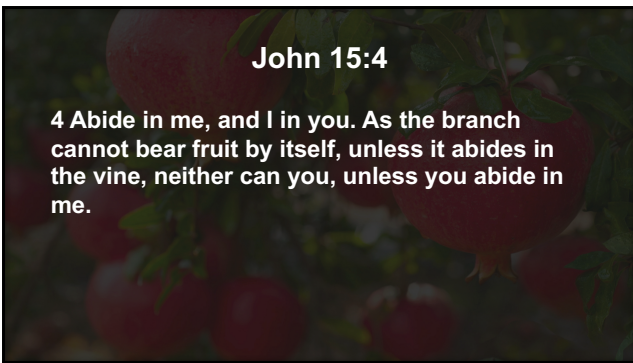
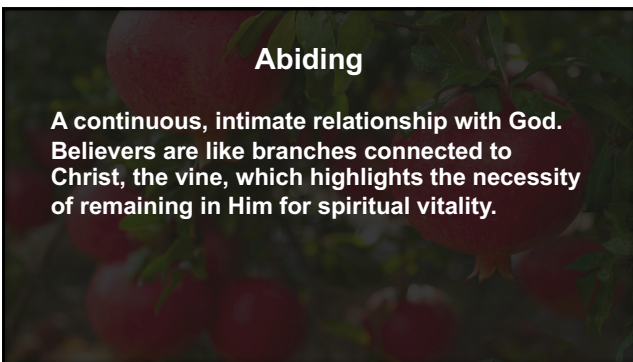

Learn to Serve

Central to the Feast of Tabernacles is serving/giving:

Deuteronomy 16 14 You shall rejoice in your feast, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant, the Levite, the sojourner, the fatherless, and the widow who are within your towns. 15 For seven days you shall keep the feast to the Lord your God at the place that the Lord will choose, because the Lord your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you will be altogether joyful.

Feast of Tabernacles

The Feast of Tabernacles, also known as Sukkot, is a Jewish holiday celebrated for seven days, starting on the 15th day of Tishrei. It commemorates the harvest and the Israelites' journey in the desert after the Exodus from Egypt, marked by dwelling in temporary structures called sukkot.
