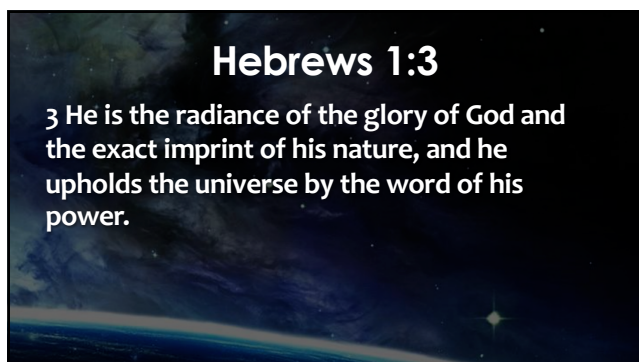
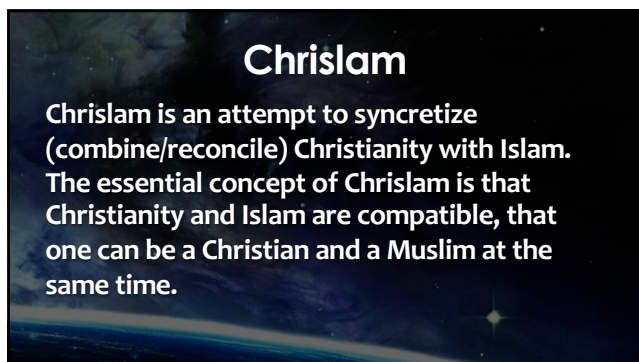

Claim: The Religion of Abraham

In Islam, the Quran is believed to be a revelation from the last prophet in the Abrahamic succession, Muhammad. The Quran itself calls Islam the "religion of Abraham" (Ibrahim) and refers to Jacob (Yaqub) and the Twelve Tribes of Israel as being Muslims.

18

John 8:51-59

51 Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death.” 52 The Jews said to him, “Now we know that you have a demon! Abraham died, as did the prophets, yet you say, ‘If anyone keeps my word, he will never taste death.’”

John 8:51-59

53 Are you greater than our father Abraham, who died? And the prophets died! Who do you make yourself out to be?" 54 Jesus answered, "If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father who glorifies me, of whom you say, 'He is our God.'

Christophany

A Christophany is an appearance or non-physical manifestation of Christ. Traditionally the term refers to visions of Christ after his ascension, such as the bright light of the Damascus Christophany.

God the Son Eternal

The trinity (God the father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit) is eternal so existed before creation and then during creation, in Genesis 1 and 2 and then thereafter during the entire Old Testament.

Since no one has seen or can see God the Father (Ex. 33:20; John 1:18, 5:37, 6:46; 1 Tim. 6:15-16),

Exodus 33:18-20

18 Moses said, "Please show me your glory."
19 And he said, "I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name 'The Lord.' And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. 20 But," he said, "you cannot see my face, for man shall not see me and live."

Jesus the representation of God

John 1:18 No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known. John 5:37, 6:46; 1 Tim. 6:15-16

Many theologians believe the times in the Old Testament where God is "seen" refer to Jesus.

Theophany

Theophany (from Ancient Greek means "appearance of god") is the appearance of a deity to a human. Only a small number of theophanies are found in the Hebrew Bible, also known as the Old Testament.

Genesis 18:3-15

3 and said, "O Lord, if I have found favor in your sight, do not pass by your servant. 4 Let a little water be brought, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree,

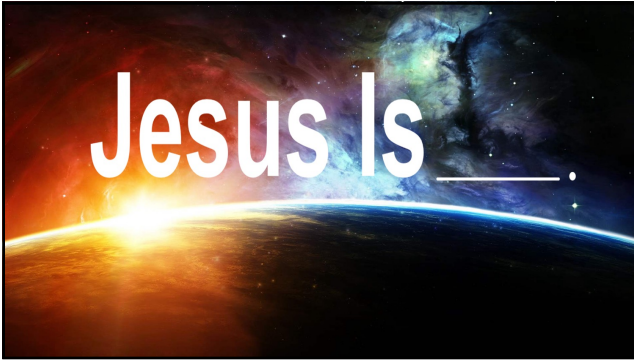
