Holiness imputed and imparted

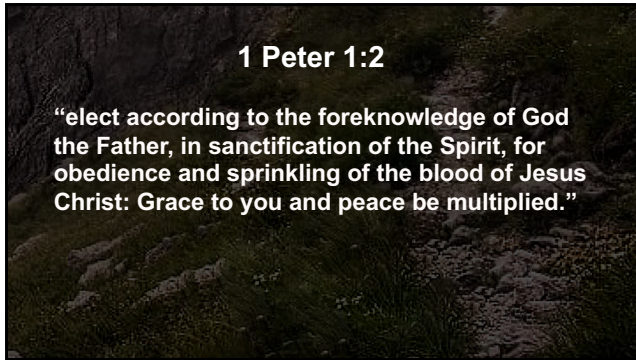
Holiness has always been imputed by a touch from God and uncleanness was imparted by a touch from something unclean that could be a living thing and inanimate object.

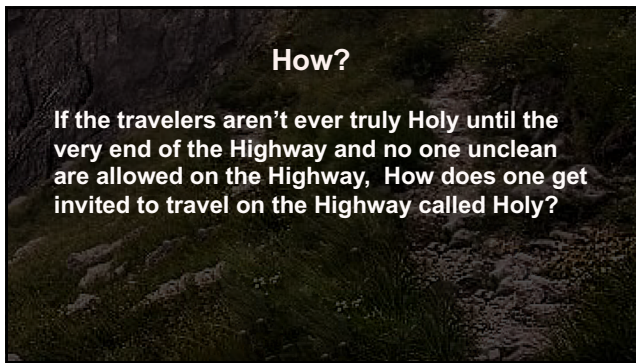

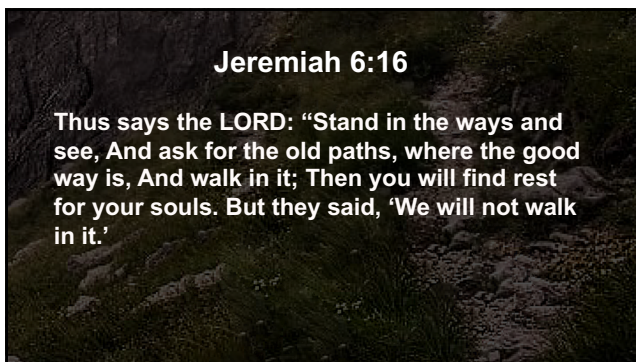

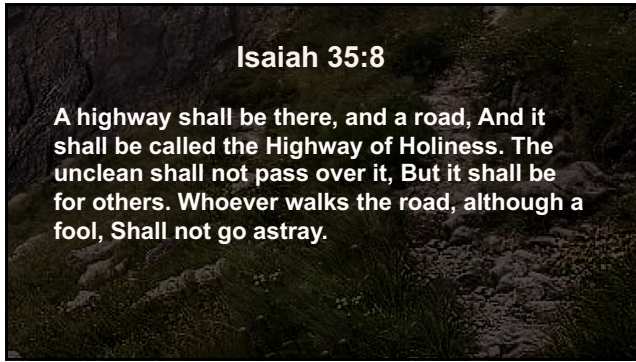
