



How to be Filled with the Holy Spirit

- 1. Build up believers (opposite of grieve)
- 2. Give lots of gifts to saints: Encourage, Teach the word, Lay hands on the sick
- 3. Welcome the presence of the Holy Spirit
- 4. Gratitude towards God Life of Praise
- 5. Praying in tongues
- 6. Work of the Lord Share your faith

Ways to Quench the Holy Spirit

- 1. Rely on our own resources instead of Him
- 2. Suppress the Spirit's work of imparting and operating spiritual gifts in the Church.
- 3. Too much structure that doesn't allow for spontaneity and leading of Holy Spirit
- 4. Diminish heartfelt emotion and affection directed to God during worship
- 5. Despising prophetic utterances
