Right of the First Born

Israel's history reveals that birthright and priesthood are linked together. In the will of God, Israel was to become God's 'firstborn', Exod. 4. 22; and a 'kingdom of priests', Exod. 19. 6. When, however, God spared the firstborn of Israel at the passover He commanded that every firstborn should be separated unto Himself, Exod. 13. 2. Later, after the worshipping of the golden calf, this privilege of priestly service is transferred to the family of Levi for we read, 'I have taken the Levites instead of the firstborn', Num. 3. 12, 45.
