Faith is looking to Jesus with the eyes of our heart and doing what he's doing

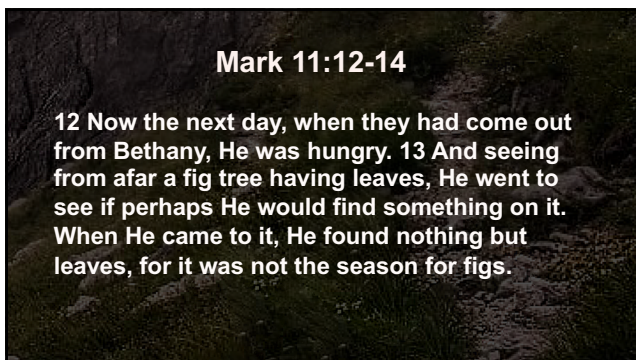

Not Faith in our Faith
