Pride inordinate opinion of one's own dignity, importance, merit, or superiority, whether as cherished in the mind or as displayed in conduct.

Pride Leads to the Sin of Presumption

Pride is the basis of all presumption. Presumption means we think we know what God wants or what ought to happen. Presumption (and pride) is the greatest of the human sins and the basis of all the others.

Voice of Pride

- 1. Sin isn't that bad
- 2. If I tried harder, I'd overcome
- 3. There are others way worse off
- 4. My sin is hidden
- 5. I know what's best for me [and others]
- 6. What I want is what God wants
