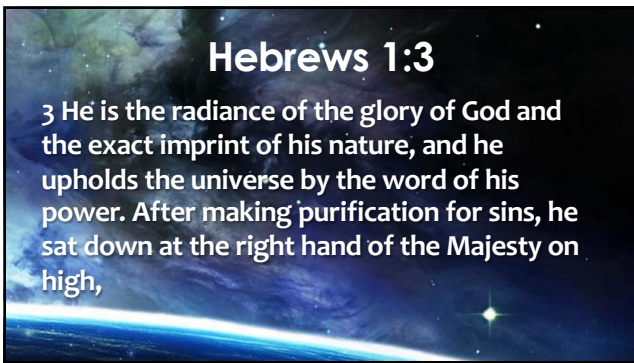
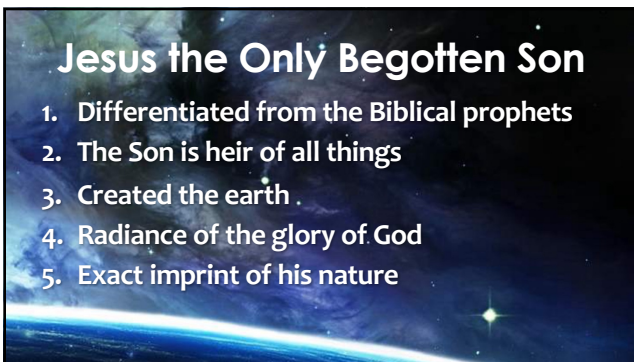

Qur'an rejects Jesus as Son of God

The Qur'an rejects the notion Jesus is divine. Particularly offensive to Muslims is the title "Son of God". (5:109-119) There can be little doubt that Muhammad understood this title to imply the physical generation of the Son from the Father, an implication he detested. (23:90-93; cf. 112)




Distant God vs Near God

A Near God enables a universal priesthood


