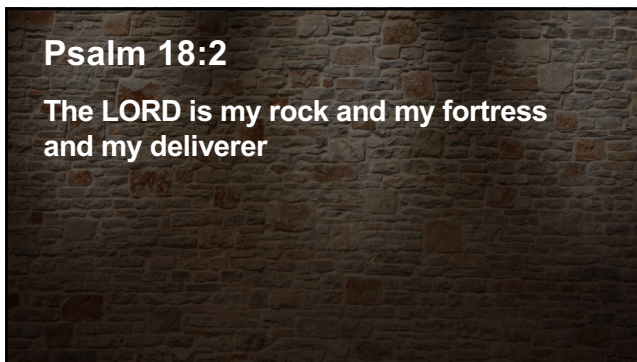

Spoken Words are Powerful

Proverbs 18:21

Prayer	Drawing Near To God
Petition	Earnest asking
Thanksgiving	Outpouring of Adoration/Thanks
Requests	Insistent and bold asking
Declaratory	Speaking words of faith with creative or destructive intention
