Jesus Calls His Name

The Name Zacchaeus is an abbreviation of Zechariah which means "**the righteous one**".

Message of Zacchaeus

"God loves sinners"

"God personally responds to genuine repentance."

The Gospel Bypasses Respectability

The Zacchaeus story is one of Jesus's most decisive demonstrations that the gospel bypasses respectability. The most disqualified person in Jericho — rich through exploitation, excluded from synagogue, avoided by decent people — became the day's host for the Son of God.
