Limits of Rational Decision-Making

- 1. It's a godly and biblical desire
 2. It will help God's people
- 3. David has the materials, labor and land
- 4. God granted David to bring the ark and tabernacle to Jerusalem
- 5. It's God's will to build the Temple6. HOWEVER, it's not God's will for David

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Proverbs 3:5-6

Why Not Lean on Understanding? 1. Limitations (inexperienced, finite) 2. Mind is influenced by passions 3. Mindsets (Inner Vows, Prejudice, Greed)

Drawing Out From the Heart

- 1. There are times the Lord will trouble (upset) my spirit and won't relent until I search out what he is saying to me. Sometimes its days and on rare occasions weeks when I'm troubled in my spirit
