 **Emphasis of Old Testament**

The emphasis of the Old Testament was on the Holiness of God. The Law demonstrated that man was weak and must be taught how to avoid defiling holy things. The worshiper must learn to humble and abase themselves in God's presence. The all-important thing was to avoid presumptuous sins.
